



Transport corridors of Uzbekistan




Transport potential




Map of major railway lines of Uzbekistan

90% - transit freights




Construction of new railway lines




Map of highways of international significance of the Republic of Uzbekistan









New programs


- 22 April 2009 was adopted Program on development of Uzbek national highway for the period up to 2014 with total length of 1501 km, including:
- Beyneu-Kungrad-Bukhara-Navoi-Samarqand-Tashkent-Andijan (E-40)
- Bukhara-Alat (M-37)
- Bukhara-Karshi-Guzar-Termez & Samarqand-Guzar (M-39)

International logistics centers (ILC) will serve as transshipment and transit-transfer base for all types of cargo, conveyed along regional transport corridors


ILC will be established alongside major transit corridors
