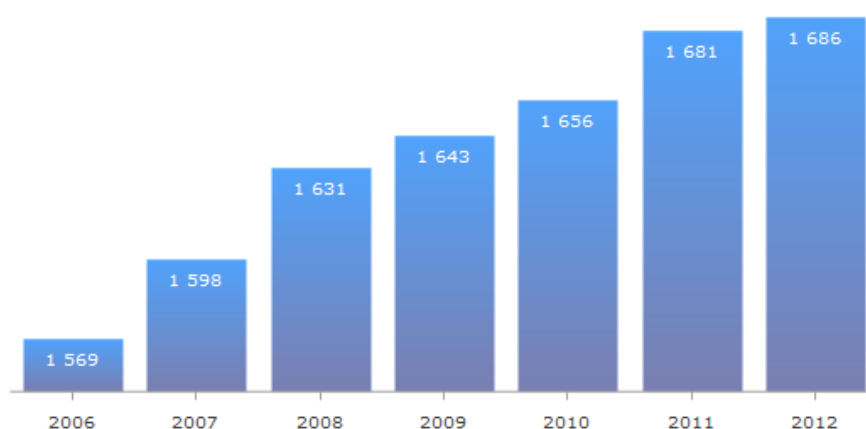

Status of accession to UN transport agreements and conventions

Note by the secretariat

1. The chart below shows the total number of Contracting Parties to international instruments on inland transport concluded under the auspices of the Inland Transport Committee (ITC). At 31 December 2012, the total number of Contracting Parties to the fifty-eight UN legal instruments in the field of transport amounted to 1686, with five new Contracting Parties to four legal instruments in 2012. As yet, out of these fifty eight, nine have not yet entered into force. For details, please refer to Annex 1. Annex 2 contains the summary tables on the status of signatures, ratifications and accessions as at 31 December 2012 for all legal instruments.
