

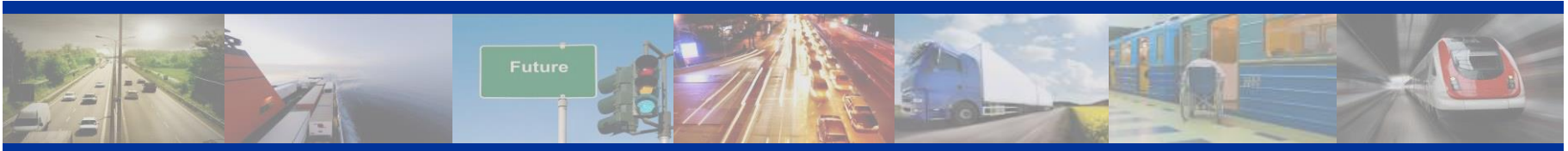

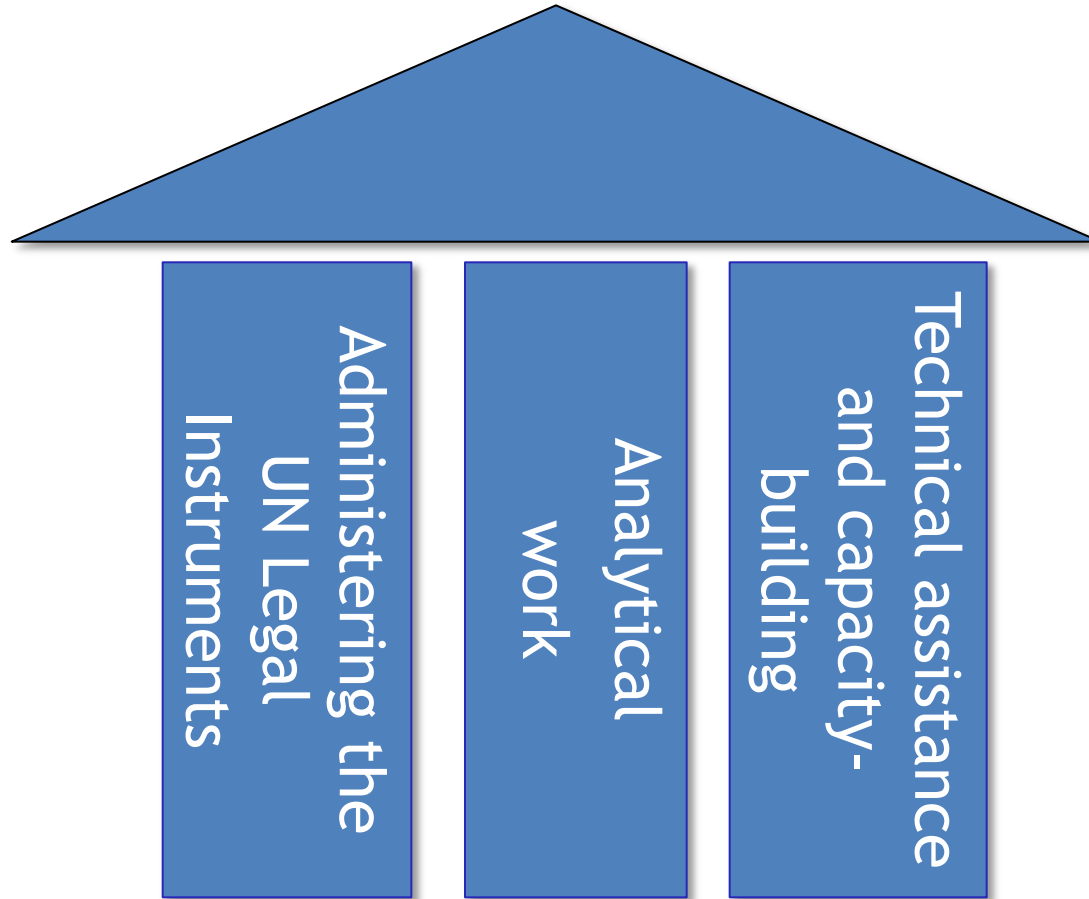

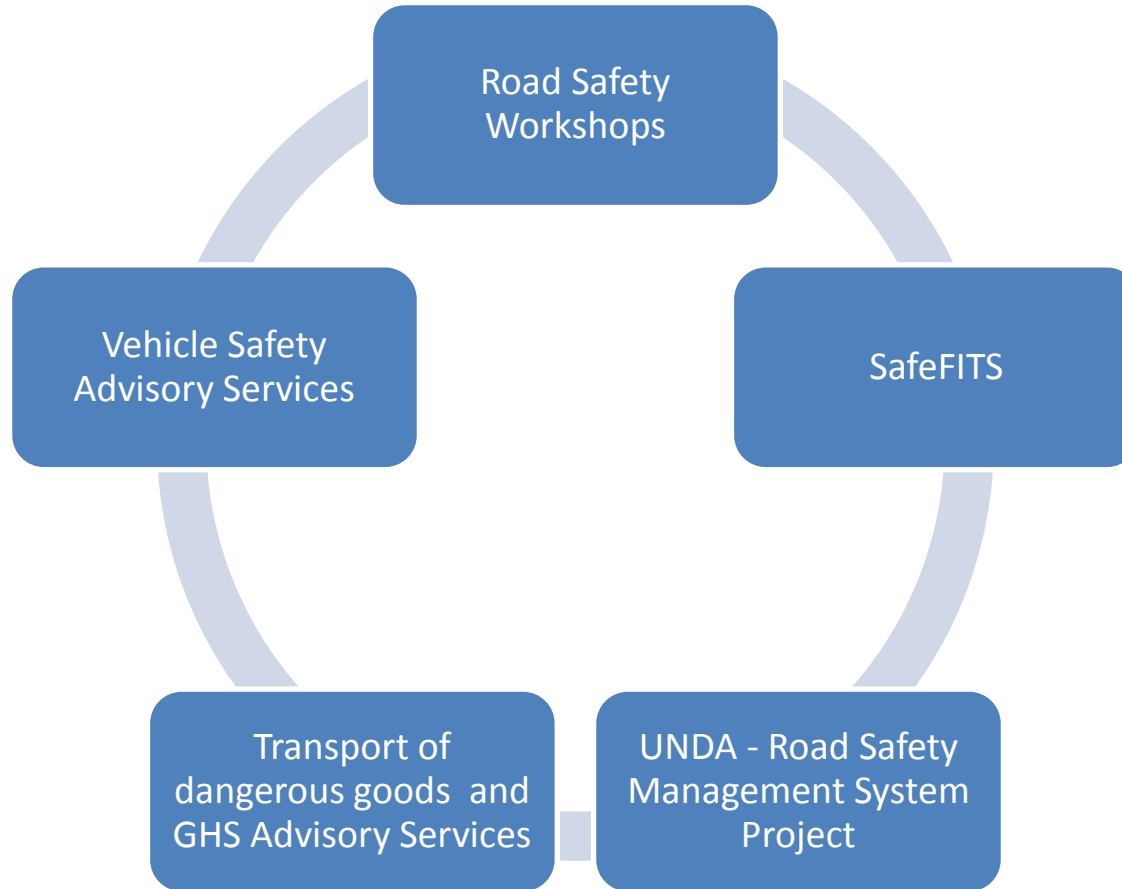

Transport systems safety



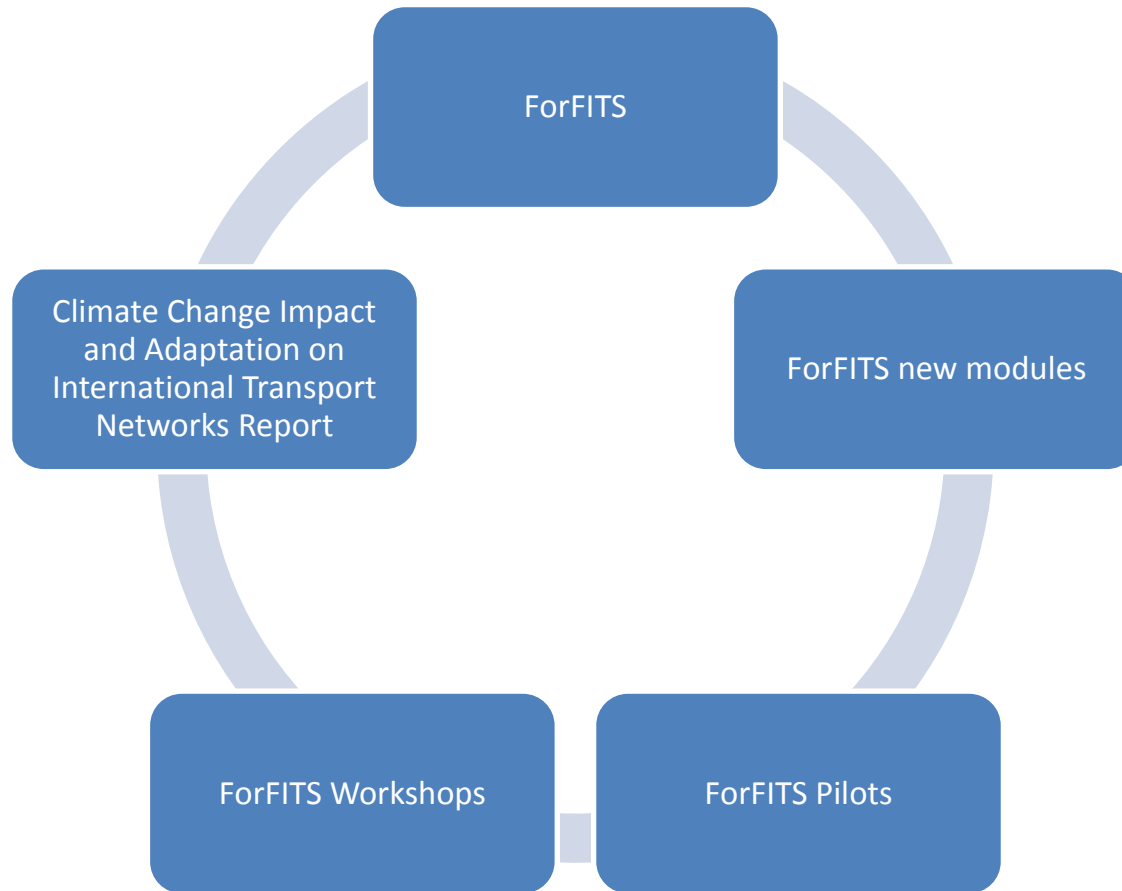
SafeFITS

- IRU supported extra-budgetary project
- Initial phase – literature review and data availability

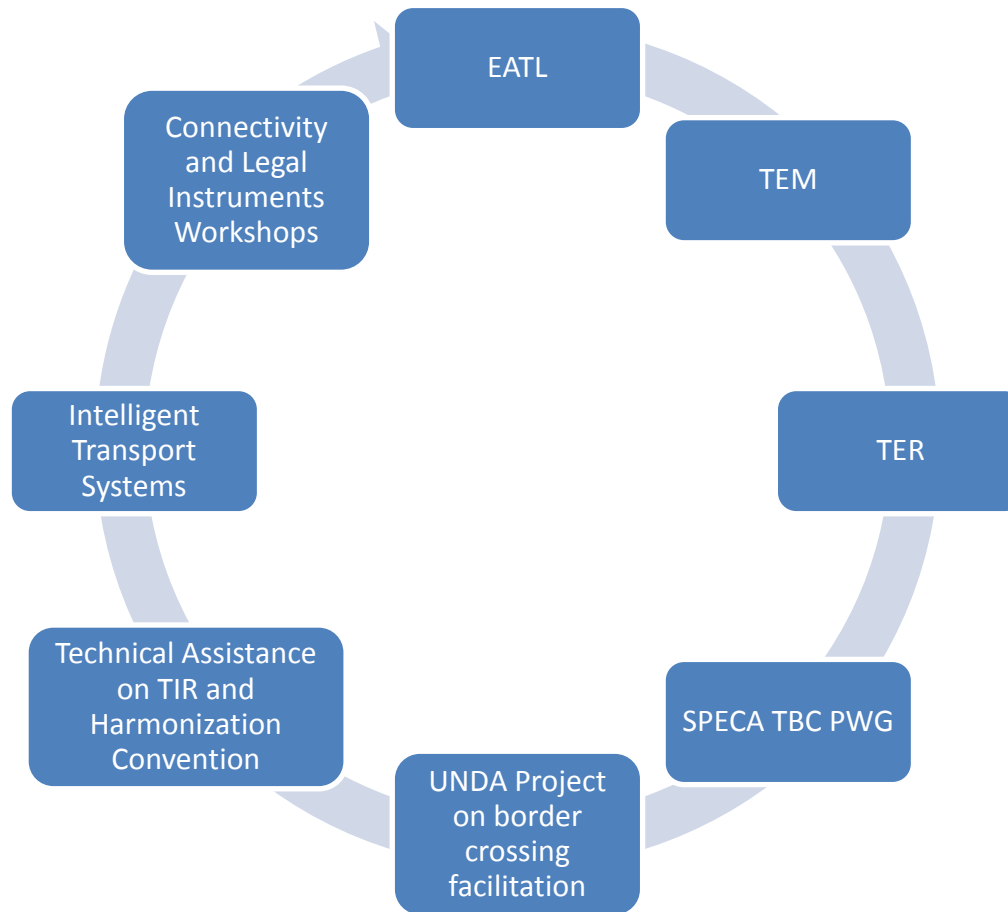
UNDA project “Strengthen the national road safety management system capacities of selected developing countries and countries in transition”

- Cooperation of 3 Regional Commissions (ECE, ECLAC and ESCAP)
- Prepare Road Safety Performance Reviews and enhance national capacities in identified road safety areas

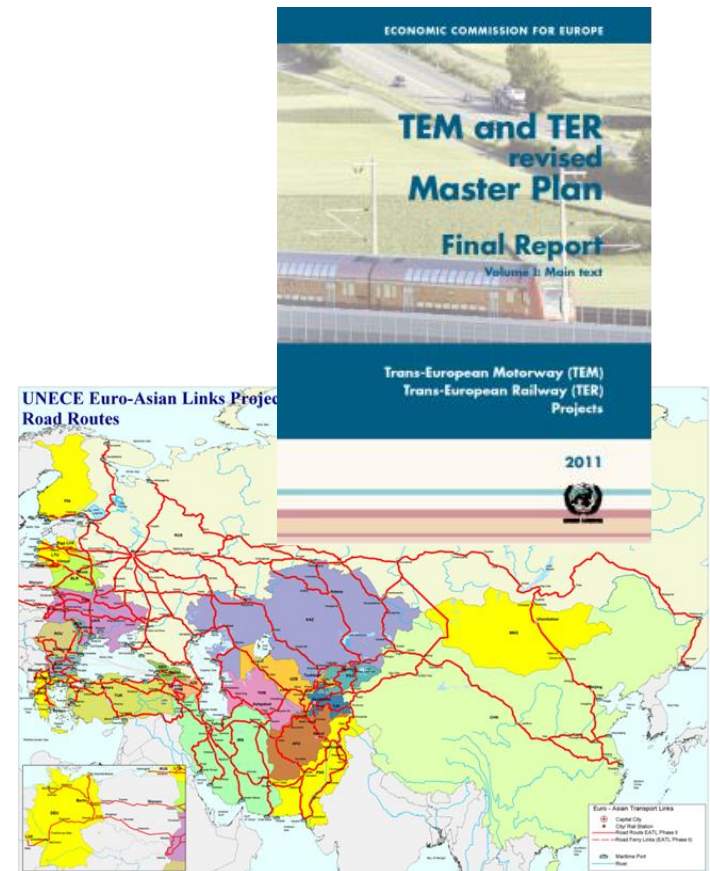

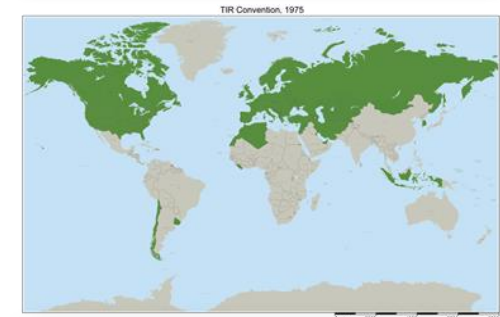

UNDA C2C Project Activities	Status
Gap-analyses	Completed in all regions
1st inter-regional Expert Group meeting	Took place on 8 December 2014 : pilot countries selected and objectives defined
Development and deployment of a secure C2C versatile electronic exchange platform	ToR ready - will start on 1 April
Provision of technical assistance to undertake actual C2C exchange of transit data or devise action plans.	RCs are preparing the ToR
Technical workshops to build capacity in the field of C2C exchange	Under preparation (for UNECE – Tbilisi – June 2015)
2nd inter-regional Expert Group meeting and Seminar: to evaluate and promote the results of the project and, more generally, the benefits of C2C exchange of transit information and the adoption of standards	Planned for October 2015
