In accordance with the programme of work of the Inland Transport Committee for 2012–2016 (ECE/TRANS/224, para. 94 and ECE/TRANS/2012/12, programme activity 02.4), the World Forum will develop, harmonize and update Regulations in order to enhance the performance of vehicles. The present document is submitted in conformity with that mandate.

Final report on the establishment of an amendment to gtr No. 3

- 1. The Executive Committee of the 1998 Agreement (AC.3) considered a proposal by Italy to amend global technical regulation No. 3 on motorcycle braking at its thirty-ninth session in November 2013 (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/AC.3/37). The proposed amendment is a consequential amendment resulting from a simplification of Regulation No. 78.
- 2. The proposal to amend the gtr was referred to the Working Party on Brakes and Running Gear (GRRF) to develop such an amendment.
- 3. At its seventy-eighth session, GRRF recommended a draft Amendment 2 to gtr No. 3 for its establishment in the Global Registry at its March 2015 session (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRRF/78, para. 21). This amendment clarifies the text of gtr No. 3 on motorcycle brake systems concerning the possible confusion in the interpretation of the terms "inoperative" and "disconnected". It also corrects some cross-references as well as titles and it introduces failure test requirements for Combined Braking Systems (CBS) to cover recent developments of braking systems.
