Objective and composition

- Objective: support dialogue on <u>technical matters</u> concerning tachograph (art. 43 Regulation 165/2014)
- Composition
 - Representatives of EU Member States
 - ♣ Individual experts from EU and non-EU AETR countries (acting in their personal capacity or representing a common interest shared by stakeholders)
 - Industry representatives (tachograph and automotive)
 - ♣ Enforcement organizations
 - Social partners
 - ♣ European Data Protection Supervisor
- Appointment: call for applications (deadline 31 March)



Operation of the Forum

- Meetings convened by the Commission
- Venue: normally Brussels
- Frequency: at least once a year
- Expenses: depending on the budgetary availability
- Possible topics
 - Enforcement practices
 - Type-approval and obtention of certificates
 - Implementation of smart tachograph
 - Other topics proposed by CP's



Application procedure

- Selection criteria
 - Relevant competence and experience in the field of the digital tachograph
 - Relevant competence and experience in enforcement of legislation related to the digital tachograph
 - ♣ Proven knowledge of the legal framework related to the digital tachograph
 - Proven capacity to represent the interest shared by stakeholders (for individual experts only)
- Supporting evidence
 - Motivation letter
 - Declaration form
 - Selection criteria document specifying fulfilment of selection criteria
 - **♣** CV

Introduction of the smart tachograph

 Article 9 Regulation (EU) No 165/2014: 36 months after the entry into force of the implementing act

Date	Step
T0 (March 2016)	Entry into force March 2016
T0 + 5 months	Protection Profiles Certified
T0 + 6 months	Test keys / certificates available to VU/MS/GNSS Modules/Cards suppliers
T0 + 21 months	Interoperability tests ready to start
T0 + 24 months	Real keys / Real Certificates available to manufacturers
T0 + 33 months T0 + 35 months	Latest date for GEN 2 Workshop cards availability Second generation tachograph cards issuing
T0 + 36 months (March 2019)	Introduction date, from which: GEN 2 VU/MS installed in all concerned vehicles Only GEN 2 Cards issued and All types of GEN 2 Cards available
