A. PROPOSAL

Part 2: in accordance with paragraph 6 of Regulation No. XXX

Part 3: in accordance with paragraph 8 of Regulation No. XXX "

The text of the Regulation,

Paragraph 6.3.6.2.2., (English only) amend to read:

" ... e.g. a maximum of 5,000 variants per 24 hours ${f for}$ 50,000 variants ${f minimum}$."

Paragraph 7.3.6.2.2., (English only) amend to read:

".... e.g. a maximum of 5,000 variants per 24 hours for 50,000 variants minimum."
