Key achievements related to transboundary water cooperation and the Water Convention at the High-level Political Forum

(New York, 10-19 July 2023)

- SDG 6 was under review in 2023: SDG 6 and interlinkages with other SDGs (11 July 2023)
- Water Action Agenda Special Event (17 July 2023)
- Treaty ceremony for new Parties The Gambia acceded to the two United Nations Water Conventions
- Side event: Water-Food-Energy Nexus amid Climate Change in the UNECE Region, organizer: UNECE (13 July 2023)
- Side event: Fostering Transboundary Water Cooperation: Unlocking Multifaceted Benefits for Sustainable Development and Peace, lead organizer: Switzerland (12 July 2023)

• Side event: The Paradox of Climate Change: Spoiler or Driver of Transboundary Water Cooperation?, lead organizer: Slovenia (18 July 2023)



Outcomes related to transboundary water cooperation and the Water Convention from the SDG Summit

(New York, 18–19 September 2023)

- The SDG Summit marked the mid-point to the deadline set for achieving the 2030 Agenda and the
 Sustainable Development Goals. It was the centerpiece of the High-level Week of the General Assembly
 and carried out a comprehensive review of the state of the SDGs. The outcome of the Summit was a
 negotiated political declaration.
- The political declaration reaffirmed commitment to the 2030 Agenda but does not refer to transboundary water cooperation.
- However, several countries highlighted in their national plenary statements the importance of transboundary water cooperation.
- A "Call to Action" to advance transboundary water cooperation was prepared and disseminated. It was
 referred to by a few speakers in different events. A social media campaign highlighted the "Call to Action".

Other major global events in October 2023 -April 2024

- COP28 of UNFCCC, 30 November-12 December 2023, Dubai
 - Several events related to water and transboundary cooperation
 - Outcomes on global stocktake and goal goal on adaptation refer to transboundary water cooperation
- World Water Day 2024, 22 March focused on "leveraging water for peace": UNECE led the preparations with UNESCO in the framework of UN-Water and the UNSG referred to the Water Convention in his statement

World Water Week 2024

(Stockholm, 25–29 August 2024)

- Theme Bridging Borders: Water for a Peaceful and Sustainable Future centered on water cooperation for peace and security.
- The Water Convention Secretariat is co-organizing several events and is co-convening a seminar series titled Institutions for Water, Peace and Cooperation.
- Co-convenors: Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE), Ministry for Europe and Foreign Affairs of France and Water Witness International

Summit of the Future



(New York, 22–23 September 2024)

- Building on the 2023 SDG Summit, the Summit of the Future aims to strengthen the multilateral system to deliver on the 2030 Agenda.
- Germany and Namibia are co-facilitators of the Summit.
- An action-oriented Pact for the Future will be endorsed by Heads of State/Government at the Summit. The draft version of the Pact is under preparation.
- The zero draft of the Pact for the Future (26 January 2024) comprised a chapeau and five chapters (on financing, peace and security, science and technology, youth inclusion and global governance) – no reference to transboundary (water) cooperation or Multilateral Environment Agreements.
- All countries and stakeholders are encouraged to put forward wording on transboundary water cooperation, both in the Pact but also in national statements during the Summit.
