# Republic of Moldova

- \* UNECE-SDC project: Implementation of Targets under the Protocol on Water and Health in the Republic of Moldova (2012-2016)
- \* *Overall objective:* population of Moldova, in particular the poor and vulnerable, benefit from improved access to safe water and sanitation, reduced water-related diseases and a protected environment
- \* Through strengthening Government capacity to implement measures towards the water and health targets (ministries for environment and health, but also regional development and construction, ...)
- \* Project outputs:
  - \* Action Plan for achieving the targets set under the Protocol;
  - \* Strategy/plan to mobilize resources towards the Action Plan developed and implemented;
  - \* Trainings for water operators and water users associations;
  - \* Norms and standards for small water operators established;
  - \* Clearing House on the Protocol established (information center);
  - \* Public awareness raising campaigns;
  - \* Partnerships and platforms for policy dialogue and decision-making established;
  - \* Promotion of the Moldovan experience through regional dialogue.

- \* Implemented by UNECE
- \* Supported by the Programme for Finland's Water Sector support to Kyrgyzstan and Tajikistan 2014-2017 (FinWaterWEI II)

# Tajikistan

- \* Implementation of national water and health targets in Tajikistan through National Policy Dialogues (November 2015 – June 2018)
- \* Implemented by UNECE and WHO/Europe and supported by the Programme for Finland's Water Sector support to Kyrgyzstan and Tajikistan 2014-2017 (FinWaterWEI II)
- \* Objective: reduce water-related diseases and improve sustainable management and use of water resources in Tajikistan through better planning of national water and health targets and implementation of selected targets
- \* Outputs: action plan and national targets developed and adopted, a number of targets selected and implemented
- \* Results: ...

# Tajikistan

- \* *“Small and Safe”*
- \* Implemented by WHO & supported by Finland (Jun 2016 – Jul 2018)
- \* **Objective:** Support long-term uptake and implementation of risk-based management approaches in rural areas and strengthen government capacities in delivering effective drinking-water quality surveillance
- \* **Expected results:**
  - \* National WSP facilitators capacitated
  - \* Ten demonstration WSPs implemented
  - \* Develop national guidance and roadmap on WSP
  - \* Health offices’ water quality monitoring capacities strengthened
