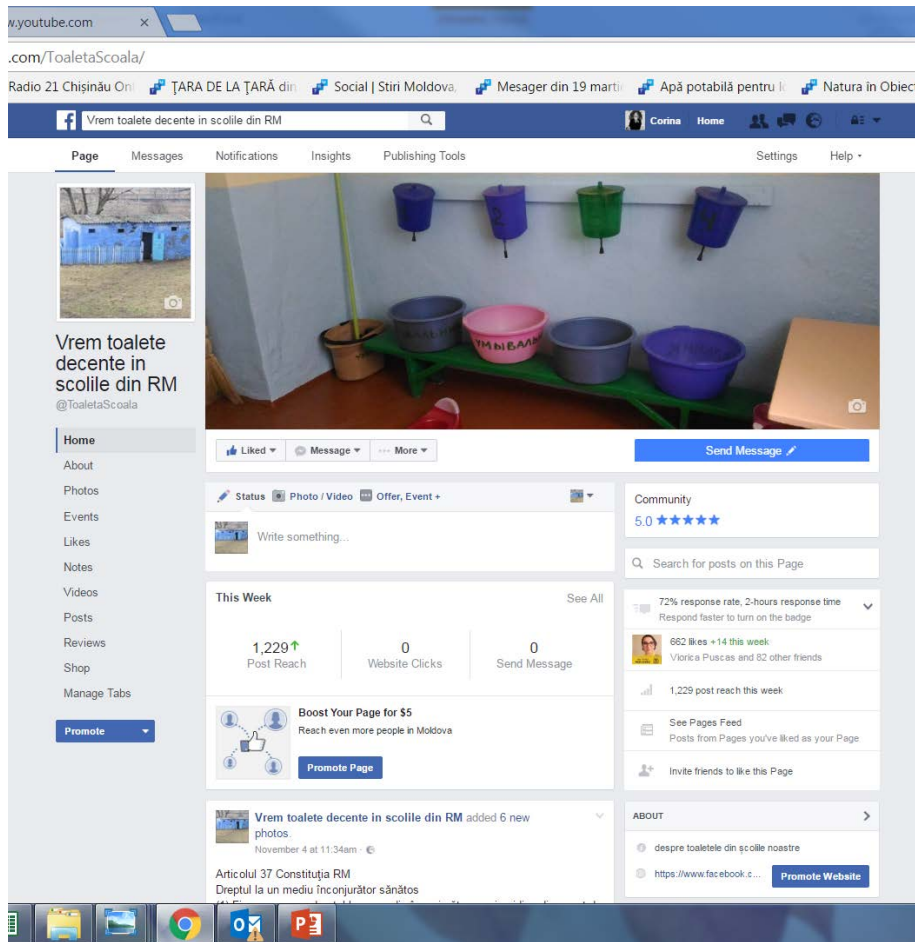


What do we do with Wash in rural schools?

Standards versus reality

- Access for all
 - Privacy
 - Comfort
 - Safety
- No sewerage
 - No water supply
 - No budget for investment or/and maintenance

What do we do with WaSH in rural schools?



- Involve parents and students

- Inform school managers about options and possibilities to improve
- Tease the Ministry of Education to consider WaSH as part of the educational process
- Involving national stakeholders (National School Sanitation Working Group)

What is next?

National level:

- To connect the decentralized responsibility with the centralized financial sources
- To play in one team (education structures, public health entities, local public authorities)
- To accept that WaSH in schools is a priority and a transversal subject
- Require money/budget for supplies, maintenance and improvements

School level/community level:

- Diagnose the WaSH facilities
- Develop improvement plans
- Budget (early) for supplies, maintenance and improvements
- Work with students and parents to maintain the facilities but also involve them in asking for better conditions
