


- Emergency response (drought) and introduction of new options for water supply and sanitation

Ecosan School Toilets

Characteristics:

- Financial contribution of the school
- Training and instructions for the users and staff
- Budgeting for supplies (soap, toilet paper) and maintenance costs
- Openness for "new" solutions



Transfer of know-how to Moldovan institutions

- Support and assistance for small (rural) water operators institutionalised service (CALM)
- Solutions for school sanitation documented and school managers informed (NCPH, Ministry of Education)
- Implementation sustainable rural projects (better technical quality, better operation set-up)
- Connect the responsibility and need with investment sources (responsibility decentralization vs financial centralization)
