# Chair's Summary of the

# ninth informal meeting between representatives of the governing bodies of the ECE Multilateral Environmental Agreements and the Committee of Environmental Policy

held at the Palais des Nations in Geneva on 13 November 2017

The meeting was chaired by Ms. Natasa Djurasinovic, Chair of the Protocol on Water and Health.

The key objectives of this meeting were to: (a) share experiences on challenges and opportunities for ratification and implementation of the respective MEAs, with a particular focus on Central Asia, and (b) share information on efforts to define the roles of the MEAs in the implementation of the 2030 Agenda.

# 1. Opening

The Chair welcomed the participants (see annex I for the list of participants). The UNECE Executive Secretary welcomed the participants and emphasized the importance of the MEAs for the implementation of the 2030 Agenda. She informed participants that the informal meeting between representatives of the governing bodies served as a model for a meeting of Chairs of the UNECE sectoral committees on the margins of the UNECE Commission Session (26-27 April 2017), which discussed the implementation of the 2030 Agenda. She also emphasized the importance of strengthening cooperation with numerous partners in the UNECE region.

2. Challenges and opportunities for ratification and implementation of MEAs - Roundtable discussion Participants discussed challenges and opportunities in working with Central Asian countries on ratification and implementation of the MEAs. They agreed that Central Asia is an important political subregion in the UNECE for further work on MEAs. All MEAs have undertaken significant efforts in providing technical assistance, trainings, advisory services, awareness raising missions, and national policy dialogues, among others. The experiences and outcomes have been different. In order to enhance the effectiveness and efficiency of capacity building activities, participants agreed that the secretariat looks into possibilities of adjusting approaches, including the introduction of new techniques, e.g. e-learning.

The MEA Chairs also noted that, although a considerable effort to support the Central Asian countries had been made, the progress achieved by the Central Asian countries towards implementation and ratification of UNECE MEAs was rather weak. Participants agreed that the awareness, ownership and political commitment needed for the effective ratification and implementation of the MEAs is currently not sufficient and needs to be enhanced. Therefore, raising public and political awareness about the benefits of implementing MEAs, including as tools to reach national SDG targets needs to be undertaken. Political awareness of the usefulness of MEAs should be raised, especially at the highest political level. This could, for example, be undertaken jointly by the MEAs together with the UNECE management. Also, external partners, such as EU delegations, IFIs, and others could help in this regard. Participants discussed the role of the CEP in awareness raising, including through national focal points and decided to return to this topic at their next informal meeting.

Speaking about the subregion, the Executive Secretary drew the Chairs' attention to the United Nations Special Programme for the Economies of Central Asia (SPECA). Participants were invited to familiarize themselves with this information and share possible comments/suggestions with the secretariat.

# 3. MEAs activities and the 2030 Agenda

Participants shared information on efforts to define the roles of the MEAs in the implementation of the 2030 Agenda. It was agreed that the SDGs provide a unique entry point to promote the MEAs, which should be further exploited. It was also agreed that awareness of the role of the MEAs play in assisting countries in achieving their commitments under Agenda 2030 should be raised in political forums, such as the Regional Forum on Sustainable Development and the High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development.

# 4. Election of next Chair of the informal meeting

The Chair of the Protocol on Water and Health, Natasa Djurasinovic, was elected as the chair of the informal meeting between representatives of the governing bodies of the ECE Multilateral Environmental Agreements and the Committee of Environmental Policy.

# 5. Next meeting

The next meeting will be held back to back with the 24<sup>th</sup> session of the CEP, in January 2019.
