Dear Aphrodite Smagadi,

In your letter dated 8 May 2012 regarding the above mentioned complaint, you asked how long it will

take for the Danish Nature and Environment Board to examine the individual complaints concerning three river management plans brought before the board by the Danish Agriculture and Food Council.

In our answer dated 21 September 2012, we reply that several decisions in principle are expected in the autumn.

We have, however, now received notification from the board (enclosed) stating that only selected problems in the complaints will be presented to the board in the beginning of December.

Thus, it will be reasonable to expect a decision on those selected problems in the beginning of 2013.
