Re: Communication to the Aarhus Convention Compliance Committee concerning compliance by the United Kingdom with the provisions of the Convention in connection with forest management (ACCC/C/2014/115)

On 16 July 2014, the secretariat of the Convention on Access to Information, Public Participation in Decision-making and Access to Justice in Environmental Matters (Aarhus Convention) received the above communication addressed to the Compliance Committee of the Convention. The communication concerns compliance by the United Kingdom with articles 4, 6, and 9 of the Convention in connection with the management of the Newborough Forest. The communication was submitted in accordance with the provisions of chapter VI of the annex to decision I/7 of the Meeting of the Parties.

After deferring its preliminary determination of admissibility in order to request the communicant to clarify and further substantiate his allegations, the Committee determined the communication to be admissible on a preliminary basis at its forty-seventh meeting (16-19 December 2014) in accordance with paragraph 20 of the annex to decision I/7. A copy of the preliminary determination on admissibility is attached. Please note, however, that the Committee has not reached any conclusions with respect to the compliance issues referred to in the communication.
