I enclose an email just received from the JNCC in response to my Fol request referred to in my further evidence response to the Compliance Committee [sent 05/12/14].

The Committee should note that JNCC state they have not provided any adjudication regarding disputed issues arising from the Newborough Science Review - highlighted text in their email. This conflicts with the conservation agency's recent announcement that JNCC's advice has allowed the Welsh Government & NRW to 'conclude' the Science Review without ever having allowed impartial arbitration to resolve key disputed issues. The implication is that JNCC have provided 'arbitration' when they have done nothing of the kind.

It appears that JNCC were never asked to provide advice on a key issue regarding the actual requirements of the Habitats Directive. Our understanding is that since the 'contemporary' area and range of protected habitat must be 'maintained or increasing' (naturally) and at site level this equates to habitat zonation within the SAC then zonation must be maintained or increasing (naturally). In other words the Directive requirement is to maintain habitat zonation present at the time of SAC designation, the 'contemporary' extent and distribution of habitats allowing for natural dune dynamics. There is no remit in the Directive to landscape a site in order to create new areas of dune habitat in order to extend full habitat zonation along further sections of coastline.

This email provides further evidence of the Welsh Government and NRW's determination to avoid fulfilling their commitment to ensure independent and impartial arbitration resolves disputed issues arising from the Newborough Science Review.
