Re: Communication to the Aarhus Convention Compliance Committee concerning compliance by Greece with regard to public participation in the preparation of a transitional national plan (ACCC/C/2017/149)

As you may be aware, following the Committee's request for clarification, on 12 April 2019 the Party concerned confirmed that it had in its response to the communication dated 29 May 2018 challenged the admissibility of the above communication.
