## Re: Decision IV/9d of the Meeting of the Parties to the Aarhus Convention

As you are aware, at its fourth session (Chisinau, 29 June-1 July 2011), the Meeting of the Parties to the Aarhus Convention adopted decision IV/9d on compliance by the Republic of Moldova with its obligations under the Convention.

Accordingly, the Party concerned submitted its progress report on 1 December 2011. At its thirty-sixth meeting (27-30 March 2012), the Committee noted with approval that the report submitted by the Party concerned was quite analytical and included a number of actions. The Committee welcomed the willingness and cooperation of the Party concerned in following up with the recommendations of the decision.

The Committee would welcome any comments on your part, before it reviews in further detail the materials submitted. All relevant information is available on the Committee's web page. It is provisionally planned that such review will take place at the Committee's thirty-seventh meeting (26-29 June 2012).
