Just two clarifications regarding AJÁ's reaction to our commnets on the CC draft report:

- 1.- Regarding fees for provision of environmental information, the cost of DIN A4 copies according to the currently in force Ordinance is **1 € per copy for any kind of information**.
- 2.- Regarding Public Participation time-frames, we just want to insist that according to the relevant legislation, **timeframes of public participation in Murcia Land Use Law are indeed beyond 20 days and exclude holidays**. We admit the untimely moment of our allegations in this regard and we apologize for that, but based on the resons and considerations expressed in our comments to the report, we have to suggest that the CC declares that Spain is no longer in a state of non-compliance with article 6.3, along the lines of Alternative 1 of its draft report.
