### **COUNTRY QUESTIONNAIRE**

Phase 3: GSQ Validation workshop with a multi-sector representation of all involved stakeholders which was attended by 27 stakeholders representing all interest groups.

Phase 4: Finalization of the final draft of the GSQ and submission for final comments

Phase 5: Integration of final comments and production of the final version of the Kosovo GSQ and the final Kosovo ICPD Beyond 2012 Report.

However, it was brough to attention that the Health Inspectorate of the Ministry of Health did take several administrative and judicatory measures against irresponsible individuals at the public and private health care sector that didn't comply with legal and other administrative provisions of the Ministry of Health. There were several court claims related to sexual and reproductive health that were processed or being processed by courts and in several cases judiciary measures were taken.

Efforts should be made to increase the use of effective methods of contraception. Nearly all women in Kosovo know about methods of contraception, so knowledge is not the barrier. Older women who are not using contraception because they think they cannot become pregnant risk unintended pregnancies. Particular attention should be given to encouraging contraceptive use among such women.

Education campaigns should target groups with low levels of knowledge about HIV/AIDS and how it is transmitted, for example, by making sure materials are translated into the languages of ethnic groups with low levels of knowledge.

More research should be done to understand fertility differences among subgroups of the Kosovo population, for example how total fertility rates differ by women's level of education.
