
What is the ITDB?

- International TIR Database
- Database containing information on all transport operators that have been authorized to use the TIR procedure
- Filled in by Customs authorities in collaboration with transport associations
- Consulted by Customs authorities
- Contains data on > 60'000 companies





ITDB in the eTIR system







ITDBonline+



- New online web application
- ITDB secure web services
- Used by both Customs authorities and national associations
- Increased integration with existing IT systems
- Increased timeliness and accuracy of data







Challenges for Customs administrations

Internationally

- Finalize the eTIR project and revise the TIR Convention
- Develop the eTIR international system

eTIR international system

- Introduce a standard declaration mechanism
- Nationally
 - Ensure interoperability between the national Customs systems with the eTIR international system
 - Develop national declaration mechanisms
 - Customs training







Challenges for the guarantee chain

- Associations
 - Reorganize the issuance of guarantees





- Transport operators training
- International organization
 - Centralize the registration of guarantees



Provide a declaration mechanism (if desired)






Challenges for transport operators
