- Request for document -> ECE/TRANS/WP.30/GE.1/2011/12





Definition

 UN/CEFACT Recommendation 33: a **Single Window** is defined as "a facility that allows parties involved in trade and transport to lodge standardized information and documents with a single entry point to fulfil all import, export, and transit-related regulatory requirements. If information is electronic, then individual data elements should only be submitted once."


