> GRPE agreed to review the proposal corresponding EC Directive 70/220/EEC, before submitting it to WP.29 and AC.1 (July 2000 session). A proposal by France concerning anti-pollution regenerative devices will also be considered.

- Proposal for a draft Regulation 3.1 concerning the specific equipment of motor vehicles fuelled by compressed natural gas (CNG)

GRPE agreed to resume consideration of further amendments to the draft Regulation only after its adoption by WP.29 and AC.1.

REGULATION No. 96 (Emissions of 4. agricultural and forestry tractors)

> GRPE agreed to consider in detail the proposals by Italy and EUROMOT, to set new emission limits corresponding to those prescribed by Directive 97/68/EC TRANS/WP.29/GRPE/2000/8 and to extend the scope of the Regulation to non-road mobile machinery.

REGULATION No. 100 (Battery electric vehicles)

GRPE agreed to resume consideration of this item, on the basis of a proposal prepared by France.
