At its $123^{\text {rd }}$ Session the World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations (WP.29) agreed the text for a draft revision of annex 2 to the Consolidated Resolution on Road Traffic (R.E.1). This has been issued as document TRANS/WP1/2001/25.

During the meeting, the representative of Belgium proposed an amendment to some of the items in Section 2 (Steering). After discussion, a revised amendment was agreed. However in document TRANS/WP.1/2001/25 the amendment was made to items 2.2.1. and 2.2.2. and not items 2.1.2., 2.1.3. and 2.1.4. as proposed.

In addition, item 2.1.1. was omitted from document TRANS/WP1/2001/25.

The text of TRANS/WP1/2001/25 should be amended as follows:-

1. Item 2.1.1 - Re-instate the following

3. Items 2.2.1. and 2.2.2.

Delete the words "or using a special adapted wheel play detector" from the first sentence in the "Method" column for both items.
