<u>Application for consultative status by the</u> European Battery Recycling Association (EBRA)

Note by the secretariat

- 1. The secretariat has received an application from the European Battery Recycling Association (EBRA) for consultative status with the Sub-Committee of Experts on the Transport of Dangerous Goods.
- 2. Amongst other issues, EBRA is interested in the question of used portable batteries, classified as hazardous wastes or not.
- 3. EBRA has also set up a working group to make proposals regarding the specific case of the transport of used lithium batteries.
