The Working Party is invited to adopt the report on its forty-eighth session (ECE/TRANS/WP.1/102).

# 3. REVISION OF THE CONSOLIDATED RESOLUTIONS R.E.1 AND R.E.2 Consolidated Resolution on Road Traffic (R.E.1)

(a) <u>Restructuring of R.E.1 and introduction</u>

The Working Party is invited to consider the revised draft introduction to R.E.1  $48^{\text{th}}$ account its session taking into comments made by **WP.1** at (ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2006/1/Rev.1). The new structure of R.E.1, updated by the secretariat  $48^{\text{th}}$ of developments since the session. on the basis appears in ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2005/15/Rev.2.

(b) Driving under the influence of alcohol, drugs and medication

The Working Party is invited to consider the draft recommendation revised by the small group (Finland, Italy, Romania, United States and WHO, under the chairmanship of Italy) following remarks made by WP.1 at its 48<sup>th</sup> session. The new draft recommendation appears in ECE/TRANS/2006/2/Rev.1.

The WP.1 is informed that the revised questionnaire (ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2006/3/Rev.1) has been sent to ECE Members States.

#### (c) <u>Improving bicycle, motorcycle and moped safety</u>

Information will be provided on the replies received to the questionnaires on improving motorcycle and moped safety. The questionnaires (TRANS/WP.1/2004/6/Rev.2 and TRANS/WP.1/2004/9/Rev.1) were disseminated by the secretariat in July 2005 with replies requested by 1 October 2005.

The Working Party will also have before it the draft recommendation on improving motorcycle and moped safety revised by the small group (United States (Chair), FEMA, FIM and IMMA) (ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2006/4/Rev.1) in cooperation with PRI.

#### (d) <u>Increasing seat-belt usage</u>

The Working Party will have before it the draft recommendation on increasing seatbelt usage revised by the small group (Spain, United Kingdom, United States (chairmanship) and FIA Foundation) (ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2006/5/Rev.1) and a proposal from the secretariat of WP.29 (ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2006/5/Rev.1/Add.1) following comments made by WP.1 at its 48<sup>th</sup> session.

#### (e) <u>Safety of pedestrians</u>

Following comments made by WP.1 at its 48<sup>th</sup> session on the draft prepared by the small group (Denmark, Israel, FIP and GRSP, under the chairmanship of FIP) on pedestrian rules and signs, a revised draft recommendation has been prepared which appears in ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2006//Rev.1.

#### (f) <u>Recommendations concerning driving permits</u>

The Working Party may wish to examine the revised draft text on driving permits for inclusion in R.E.1 (ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2006/9/Rev.1).

#### (g) <u>Communication and road safety campaigns</u>

The Working Party is invited to consider the revised draft text on communication and road safety campaigns (ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2005/16/Rev.1).

(h) <u>Daytime running lamps</u>

The Working Party is invited to consider the revised draft text on daytime running lamps prepared by the secretariat (ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2005/17/Rev.2).

#### (i) <u>Driving at night</u>

The Working Party is invited to consider the revised draft recommendation on driving at night (ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2005/18/Rev.1).

(j) Speed

The Working Party is invited to consider a draft text on speed (TRANS/WP.1/2005/19) prepared by the small group composed of France (chair), Portugal, Switzerland and the secretariat.

#### (k) <u>Mobile phones</u>

The Working Party is invited to consider a new draft text on driving and mobile phone use submitted by France (ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2006/8).

#### (l) <u>Contents of first-aid kit</u>

The Working Party may wish to consider the proposal relating to the contents of the first aid kit to be carried on board vehicles, which is contained in ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2004/17/Rev.1.

#### (m) <u>Safety of children</u>

The Working Party may also wish to examine a revised draft text for R.E.1 concerning the safety of children (ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2006/11).

#### (n) <u>Special rules concerning certain categories of vehicles</u>

The Working Party may also wish to examine a revised draft text for R.E.1 on special rules concerning certain categories of vehicles (ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2006/12) submitted by the representative of PRI.

#### (o) <u>Driving instruction</u>

The Working Party may also wish to examine a revised draft text for R.E.1 concerning driving instruction prepared by the representative of the European Commission (ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2006/13).

#### (p) <u>FEVR proposals</u>

The Working Party may also wish to examine a revision proposal submitted by FEVR (ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2006/10).

#### (q) <u>New issues</u>

The Working Party is invited to consider preliminary draft texts for possible inclusion in R.E.1 concerning new issues such as complementary equipment required on

board vehicles. The proposals, prepared by the secretariat, will be presented in Informal documents.

#### Consolidated Resolution on Road Signs and Signals (R.E.2)

#### (r) <u>Safety in tunnels</u>

At its 48th session, the WP.1 had agreed in principle to modify paragraph 1.11 of R.E.2 in order to introduce the proposal made by the Working Party on the Transport of Dangerous Goods (WP.15) concerning the use of signs C,3h and D,10, but asked the Legal Group to examine the text submitted prior to its adoption at the 49<sup>th</sup> session.

The reports of the meeting of the Legal Group held on 16-17 January 2007 and 24 March 2006 are contained in documents ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2006/15 and ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2006/16. A draft recommendation prepared by the secretariat modifying paragraph 1.11 of R.E.2 appears in ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2006/14.

#### 4. PREPARATION OF THE FIRST GLOBAL ROAD SAFETY WEEK

The Working Party will be informed about the latest developments concerning the preparation of the First United Nations Global Road Safety Week in 2007 and more particularly about the work of the small group created by WP.1 for this task (France, Italy, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Russian Federation, Switzerland, WHO, European Commission, PRI, FIA Foundation for the Automobile and Society, LaserEurope, secretariat).

The report of the group's third meeting held on 23 March 2006 will be made available in an Informal document (in English only). An oral report will be made on the group's fourth meeting held on 26 June 2006.

#### 5. OTHER BUSINESS

The Working Party may wish to discuss any other business under this agenda item.

The  $50^{\text{th}}$  session of the Working Party is scheduled to be held from 7-10 November 2006.

#### 6. ADOPTION OF DECISIONS

The Working Party will adopt a list of decisions taken at its forty-ninth session based on a draft prepared by the secretariat.
