## ATTENDANCE

The Task-force meeting on Statistics on the Volume of Road Traffic (vehicle-kilometres) was held in the Palais des Nations in Geneva under the chairmanship of Mr. Erik Grib (Denmark). Representatives of the following UNECE member States participated: Czech Republic, Denmark, France, Germany, Greece, the Netherlands, Romania and Slovakia. The UNECE secretariat, Eurostat and the ECMT were also present (see Annex).

## **ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN**

The Task-force meeting elected Mr. Erik Grib (Denmark) as the Chairman of the Meeting.

## **ADOPTION OF AGENDA**

The Task-force meeting **adopted** the provisional agenda prepared by the secretariat (<u>Informal document</u> <u>No. 1</u>).
