Proposed revision to Special Provision 188

## Submitted by the Portable Rechargeable Battery Association (PRBA), and RECHARGE

- 1. PRBA and RECHARGE proposed in ST/SG/AC.10/C.3/2008/94 to exempt button cell batteries contained in equipment and on circuit boards from the marking requirements in paragraph (f) of Special Provision 188. This provision currently reads:
  - (f) Except for packages containing no more than four cells installed in equipment or no more than two batteries installed in equipment, each package shall be marked with the following:
- 2. In order to provide an exemption from the marking requirements for button cell batteries contained in equipment and on circuit boards, we propose to amend paragraph (f) in Special Provision 188 as follows:
  - (f) Except for packages containing button cell batteries installed in equipment (including circuit boards), or no more than four cells installed in equipment or no more than two batteries installed in equipment, each package shall be marked with the following:
