Minimum horizontal visibility angles

#### Direction indicators for the front of the vehicle


<u>Category 1</u>: for use at a distance not less than 40 mm from the headlamp;

Category 1a: for use at a distance greater than 20 mm but less than 40 mm from the


headlamp;

<u>Category 1b</u>: for use at a distance less than 20 mm from the headlamp.
