### Submitted by the Government of Germany

#### Introduction

1. According to sub-paragraphs 8.2.2.7.1.3 and 8.2.2.7.2.3, the Administrative Committee shall prepare a list of questions to be used for the examinations following the basic training courses and the specialization courses on gases and chemicals. This work has almost been completed.

2. During the last session, the ADN Safety Committee discussed how to make the list of questions accessible to the public. It was decided that all questions would be posted on the UNECE website and that a reference should be added at appropriate locations in ADN.

## Proposal

3. Germany proposes to add the following text as a footnote to the term "list of questions" in 8.2.2.7.1.3 and 8.2.2.7.2.3:
