

e.g. combined impact of demographic changes, urbanisation and political power shifts


Technological innovations

e.g. safe and clean vehicles
























Breaking the spell of the Vicious Circle





Public Expenditure bias




- control of PE
- Flexibility in distribution




Transport sector concerns
