Regional transport organization established by the MoU (June 11th, 2004).


The main objectives of the SEETO cooperation:

- Develop the SEETO Comprehensive Network;
- Improve and harmonize regional transport policies and technical standards for the SEETO Comprehensive Network development;
- Maintain an effective coordination and communication network;
- Integrate the SEETO Comprehensive Network in the framework of the wider Trans European Network.

Steps undertaken

Road Safety Working Group

 SEETO brings a wide network of institutions and experts in the SEETO area in the field of road safety and road engineering, which can be mobilized for different purposes.

- Component B: Road Safety Auditing
 - A draft short term Road Safety Strategy;

 - Testing RSA procedures through pilot projects with reference to design documents and existing roads on the core road network.
