




locating tables with ERA data in the Eurobase table-tree:




locating tables with CARE data in the Eurobase - Transport - Multimodal data (tran) -












AIR

- Cooperation with EASA
- Administrative Agreement to disseminate EASA data through Eurobase recently signed
- Four new tables with air accident casualties in different aviation categories are about to go online
- Metadata with definitions will be available in parallel
- Fifth table foreseen: number of accidents









Maritime

- EMSA Permanent Cooperation Framework on maritime accidents and incidents
- Data from the EMCIP data base is foreseen (underreporting problem)
- EMSA December 2014: dissemination of the first annual overview on maritime accidents
- Should cover Eurostat needs (persons injured and killed by type of ship, by category of person)
- Ongoing discussions (location of accident occurrence, flag & transport related)
