


Road traffic fatalities by region, 2003–2013 (UNECE, 2015)



Figure 1: Passenger-km by road and by rail (million)




Figure 2: Casualties (fatalities and injuries, per million inhabitants) &= 1,000






Figure 3: Inland transport modal split Freight (Tonne-km)









Figure 3: Inland transport modal split -Freight (Tonne-km)






The Dominican Republic (WHO, 2013)











Viet Nam (WHO, 2013)
