GLOBAL ROAD SAFETY PARTNERSHIP

- Work together all sectors have a role and a responsibility.
- Develop sustainable institutions local ownership of problems and solutions.
- Share knowledge build on Good Practice.
- Provide a neutral forum for government, business, and NGOs to discuss as peers



- Leverage funding and know-how from all sectors – add more value to available resources.
- Adapt proven measures to fit the local context.
- Bring together partners with little experience of working together.
- Scale-up from pilot projects.



Impact of Partnership

- ROAD SAFETY PARTNERSHIP
- GRSP in Brazil working with Municipal governments in towns of approx 500,000 population
- Began in 2000 with 4 towns now a total of 18 towns in 5 States
- Numbers of partners involved exceeds 100 always the relevant municipal departments – with local businesses and NGOs
- Examples of results:
 - Reduction in of number of crashes, fatalities&injuries around 50% in Sumaré, Sao Paolo State, from 2001 to 2005
