

Structure of the road transport industry


Average size of goods road transport companies for hire and reward, 2004

Role of Associations

- Counter structural imbalances Pooling
- Defence of interests Lobbying
- Services to members Facilitating
 - Commercial
 - Legal
 - Visas, passport
 - Transport documents
 - TIR management
 - Advisory services (investment, technical, etc.)

Co-operation in PPP

- Transport is a public affair
- No player can act alone
- Working together is a must
- Best form: PPP = public-private partnership
 - Consultation on legislation in preparation
 - Joint working bodies (committees) with authorities and parliament
 - Mutual invitations to events
 - Other forms of a *permanent dialogue*




