





SDG 8 on Employment, target 8.5: "By 2030, achieve full and productive employment and decent work for all women and men, including for young people and persons with disabilities, and equal pay for work of equal value."

Persons with disabilities make up an estimated one billion of the world's population with about 80% being of working age. However, many persons with disabilities, particularly women and youth, are unable to achieve their full potential. Employers miss out on their potential and possible business benefits. This is due to attitudinal, physical and informational barriers. SDG 8 specifically references persons with disabilities to achieve full and productive employment and decent work for all. This session will provide background information on the employment of persons with disabilities and give best practice examples aligned with the article 27 of the UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities: work and employment.
