



Lars Hansson

Board member & co-founder of the Swedish SIE Group

In 1988 Lars Hansson co-founded Edison Solutions AB, a software company specializing in accounting software. Hansson has since gained three decades of experience in the field of accounting and audit, specializing in file transfer, APIs and system integration.

In 1992 Hansson was one of the founders of the SIE file formats and the SIE Group, a non-profit organization whose members represent both the accounting software industry and the accounting and audit associations. The SIE file formats for transfer of account balances and journal entries are used by nearly 100 % of all Swedish companies.

Hansson is a member of the BAS-stakeholder Association board, a non-profit organization with the objective to manage and develop the generally accepted “BAS-kontoplanen” chart of accounts and publications connected to the chart of accounts. Approximately 95 % of all companies in Sweden use some form of “BAS-kontoplanen”.

Hansson is since 2017 a member of The Swedish Accounting Standards Board (BFN), which is a government authority with the task of developing generally accepted accounting principles. BFN issues rules and information material regarding the Bookkeeping Act and the Annual Accounts Act.
