UN Entrance Badges

All delegates will be issued with an entry badge for the period 29 April–3 May (irrespective of which meetings you are attending during the Week, this includes the Joint UNECE and SPE Swiss, France and Italian Sections Lecture on “Uberizing Energy” on Thursday 2 May).

UN badges are obtained at the Pass and Identification Unit of the UNOG Security and Safety Section, located at the **Pregny Gate**¹, 14, Avenue de la Paix (opposite the ICRC Building). Directions to Meeting Rooms

PLEASE NOTE: due to new security measures at the Palais des Nations, conference participants can now only enter through four doors: A15, A17, C6 and E40 (see map on last page).

Salle XII – main meeting room

Door A17 is on level 2. From Door A17, follow the corridor to take the elevator A17 up one floor to level 3. Salle XII is located to the left of the elevator in the main hallway.

Salle XV

From Door A17, follow the corridor to take the elevator A17 up one floor to level 3. Follow to your right through the main hallway. Turn right and take the escalator A11 down one floor to level 2. Room XV is located opposite the elevator.

Salle S1

From Door A17, follow the corridor to take the elevator A17 up one floor to level 3. Follow the main hall to the right all the way through to the C building and continue beyond the Delegates’ Lounge. Take the elevator C5 to level 0. Exit to the left and follow the ground floor hallway (“rez-de-chaussée”) ahead. S1 is situated in the corner on level 0 (close to door S2).

Salle S4

From Door A17, follow the corridor to take the elevator A17 up one floor to level 3. Follow the main hall to the right all the way through to the C building and then on to the S building. Continue along the hallway ahead S4 (Moroccan room) is situated in the corner on level 3.

Delegates are encouraged to download this map as it highlights the location of the meeting rooms, the UN cafeteria, coffee lounges and bars, as well as the bus numbers that stop at the Pregny Gate and the bus and tram numbers that stop at the Nations Gate (Place des Nations). The Pregny Gate is a 500 metres walk up the hill (Avenue de la Paix) from the Nations Gate.

[Public transport by tram and bus](#)

The Palais des Nations is served by several tram and bus lines: Buses 8, 28, F, V and Z serve Pregny Gate (Appia stop) where the Security/Registration office is located.

Tram 15, as well as buses 5, 8, 11, 22, 28, V, F and Z, serve the Place des Nations. Place des Nations, where the Nations Gate is located, is some 500 metres away from the Pregny Gate. Buses 5 and 28 serve Geneva Airport from the Place des Nations. 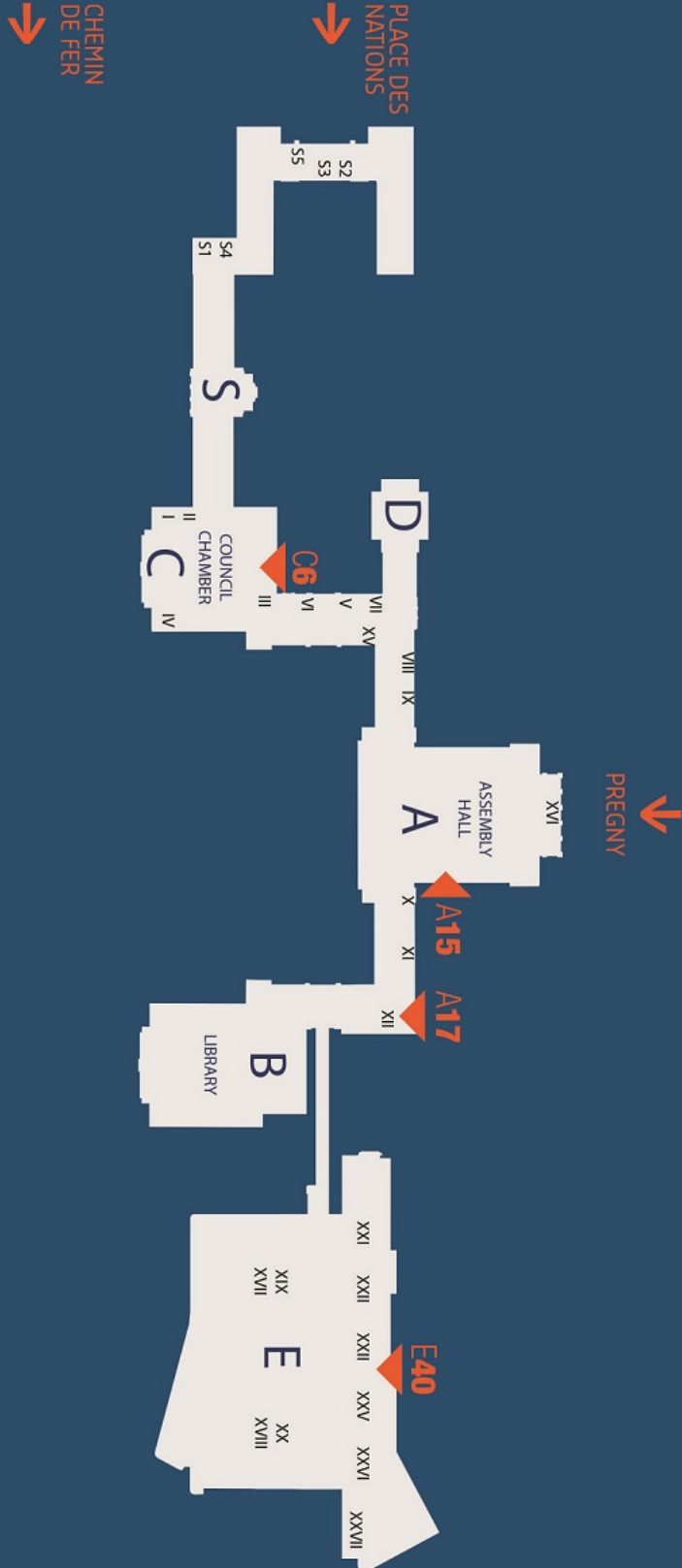
