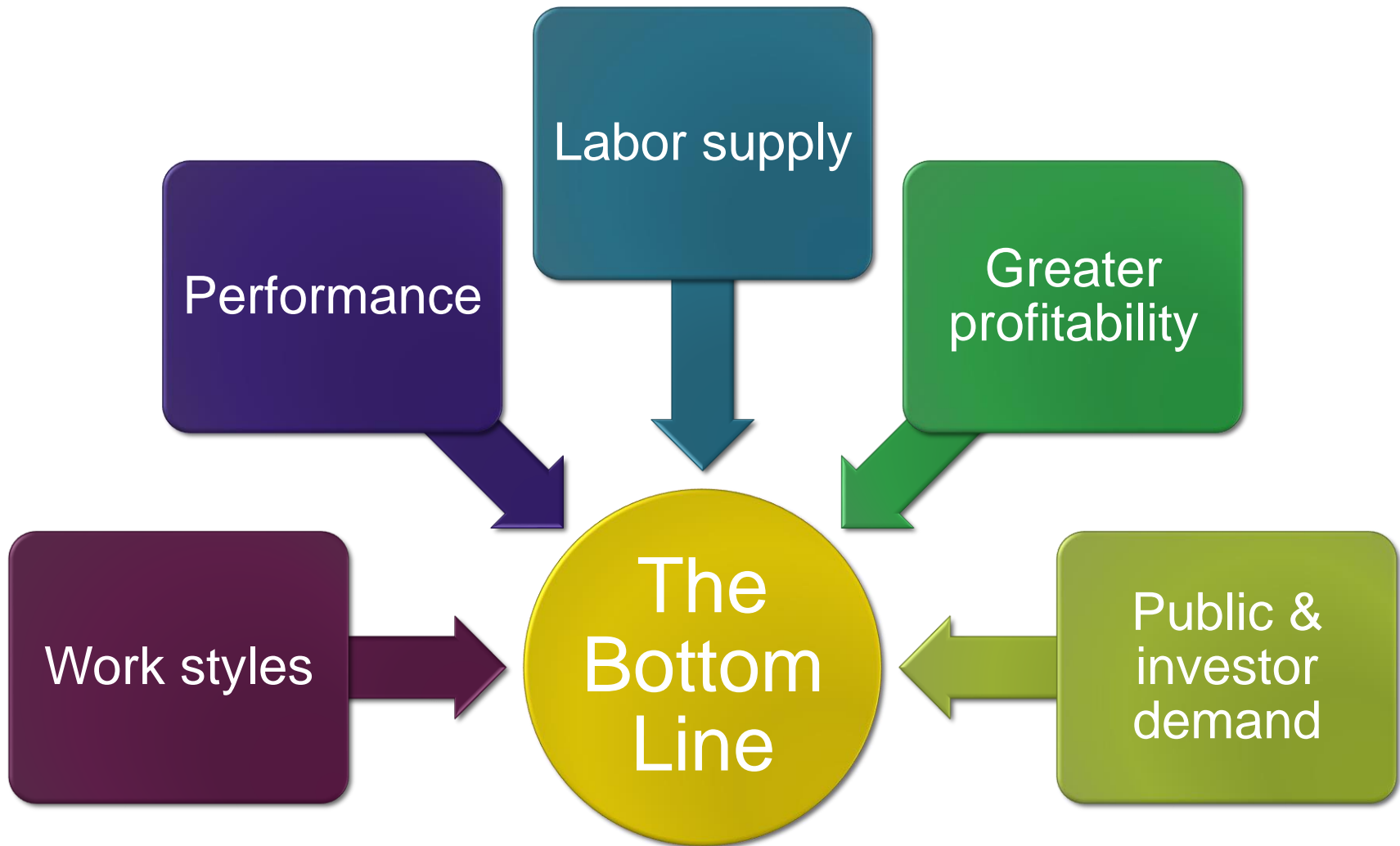

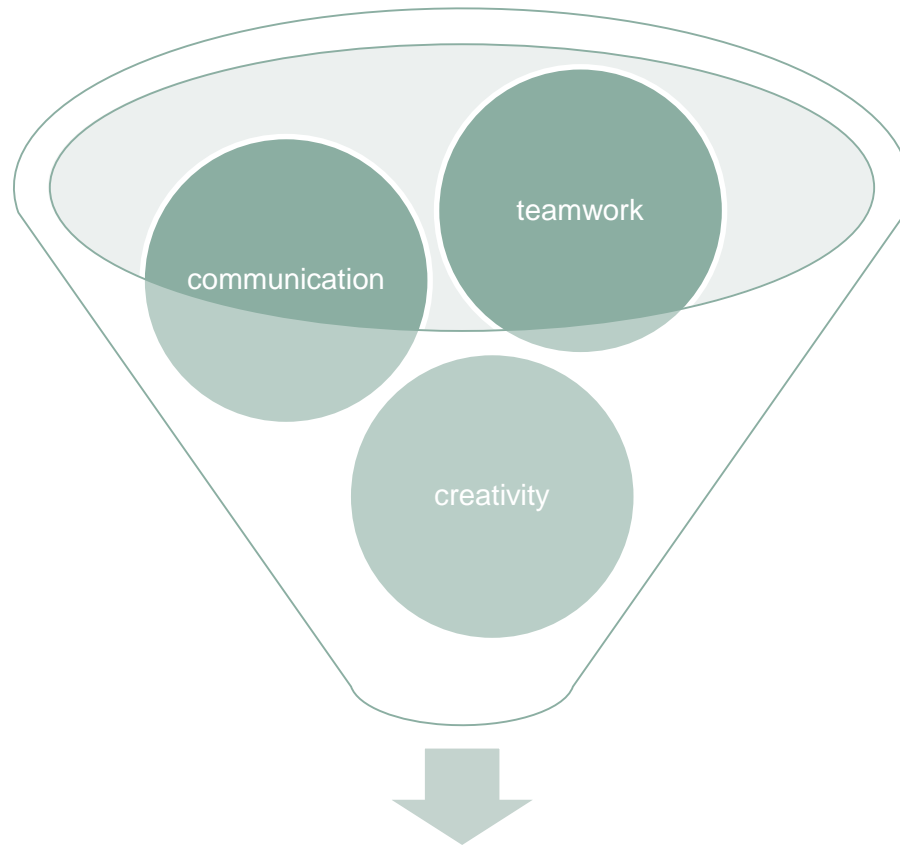

1. Female inclusion is good for business

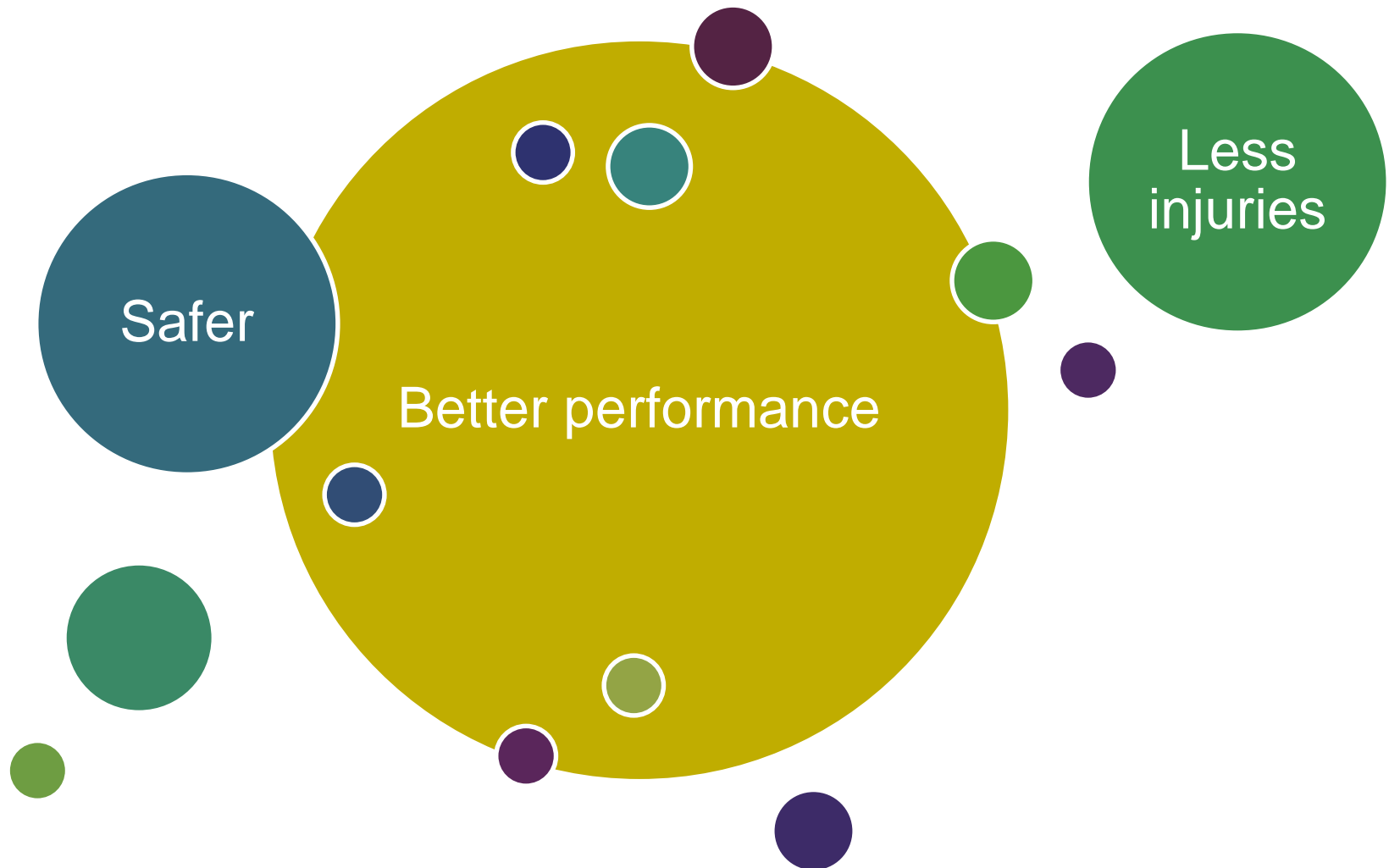


Female inclusion = diverse work styles

Female inclusion = better performance



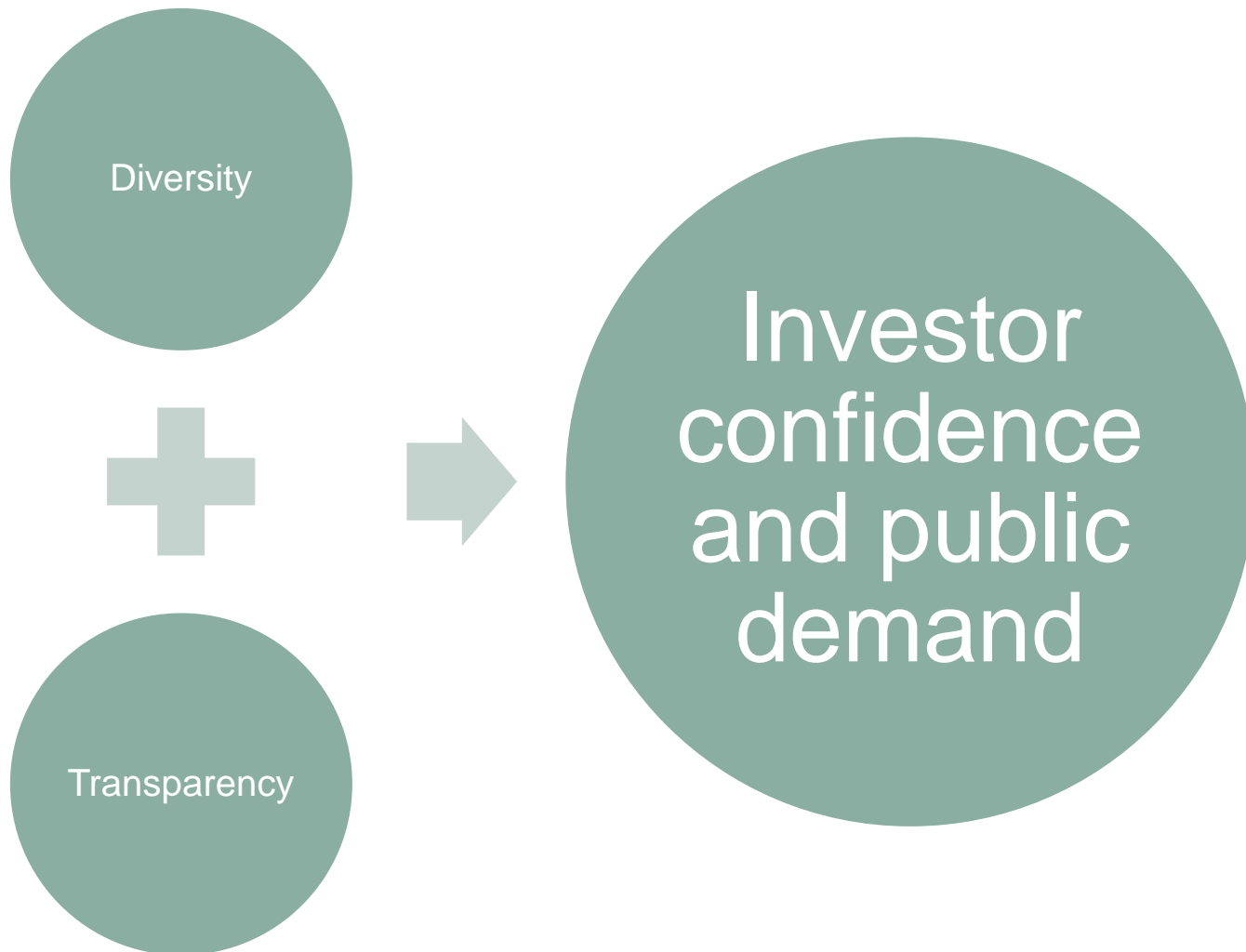
Female inclusion = labor shortages



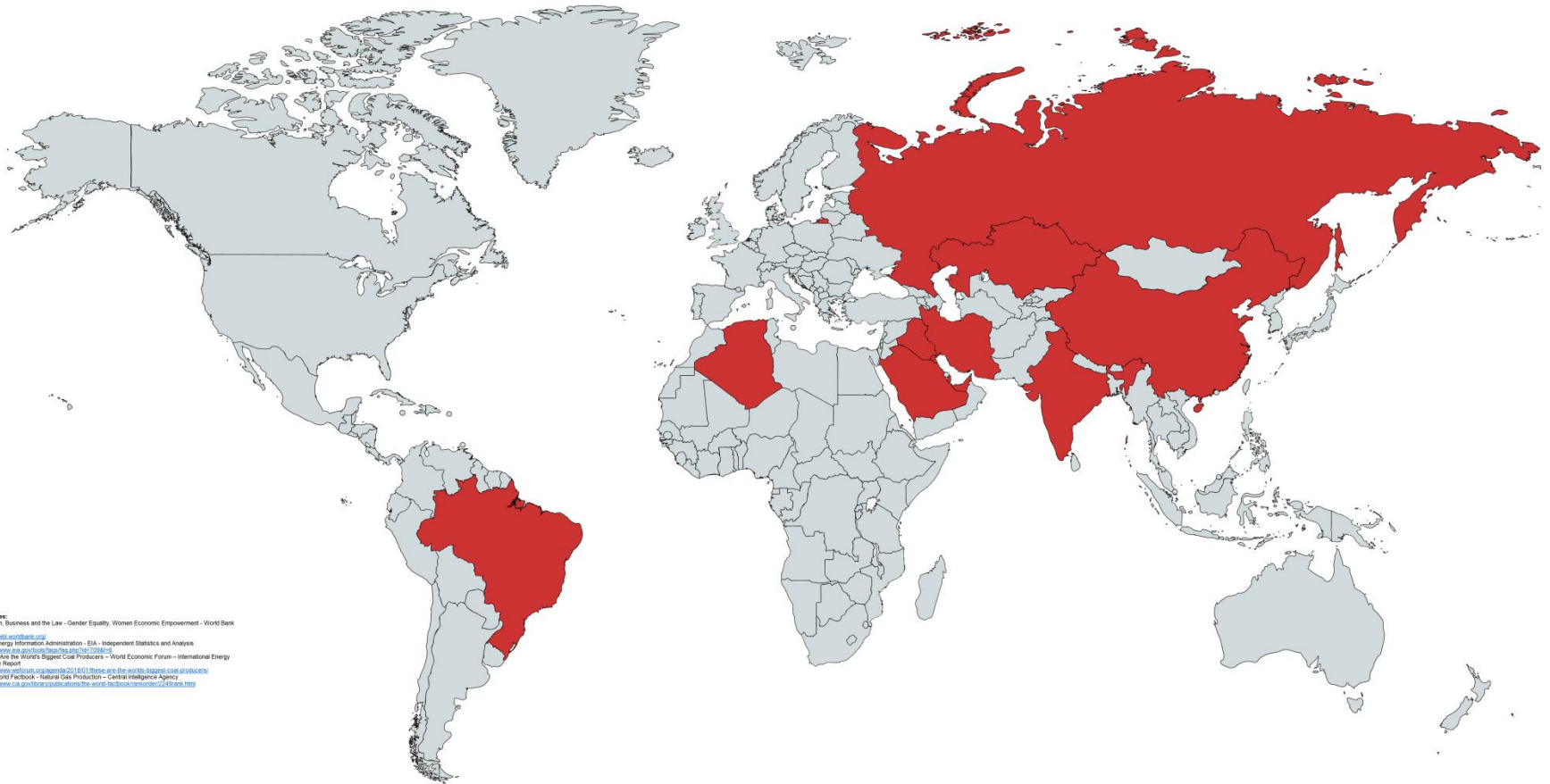

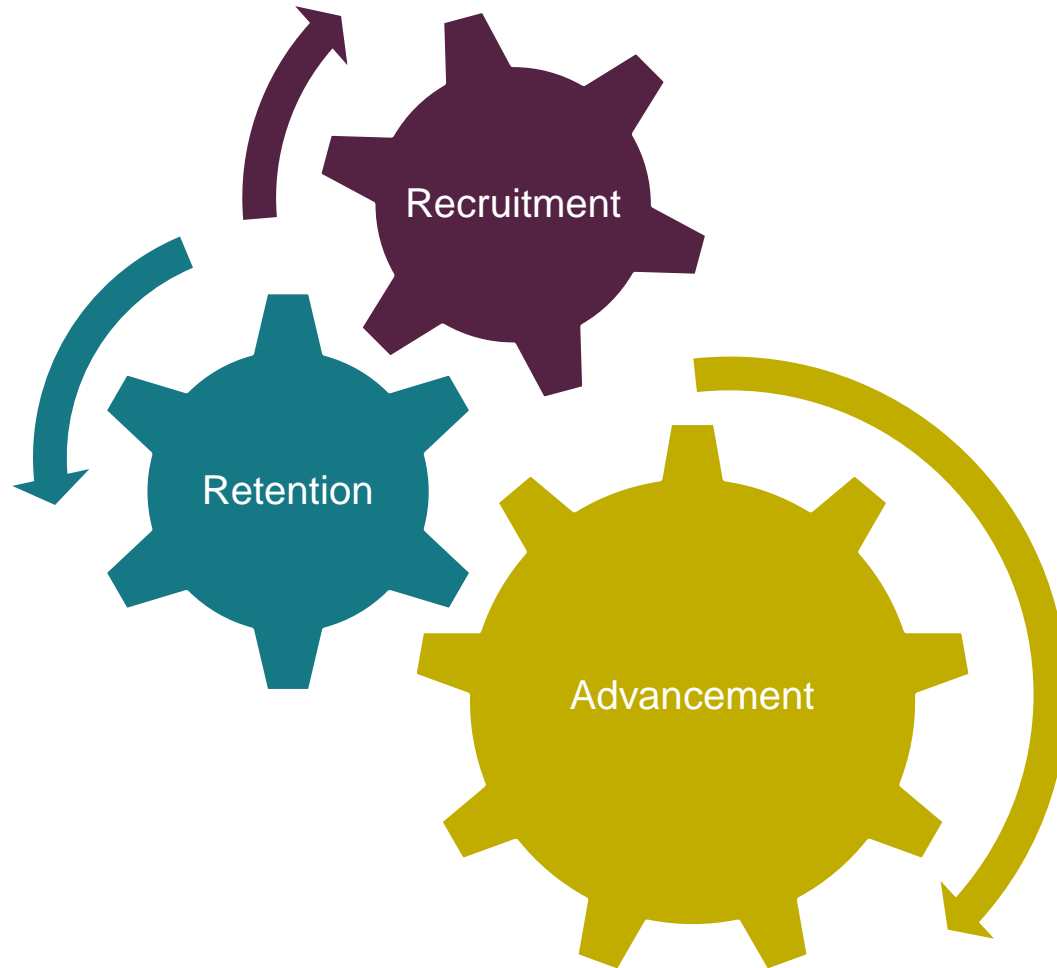

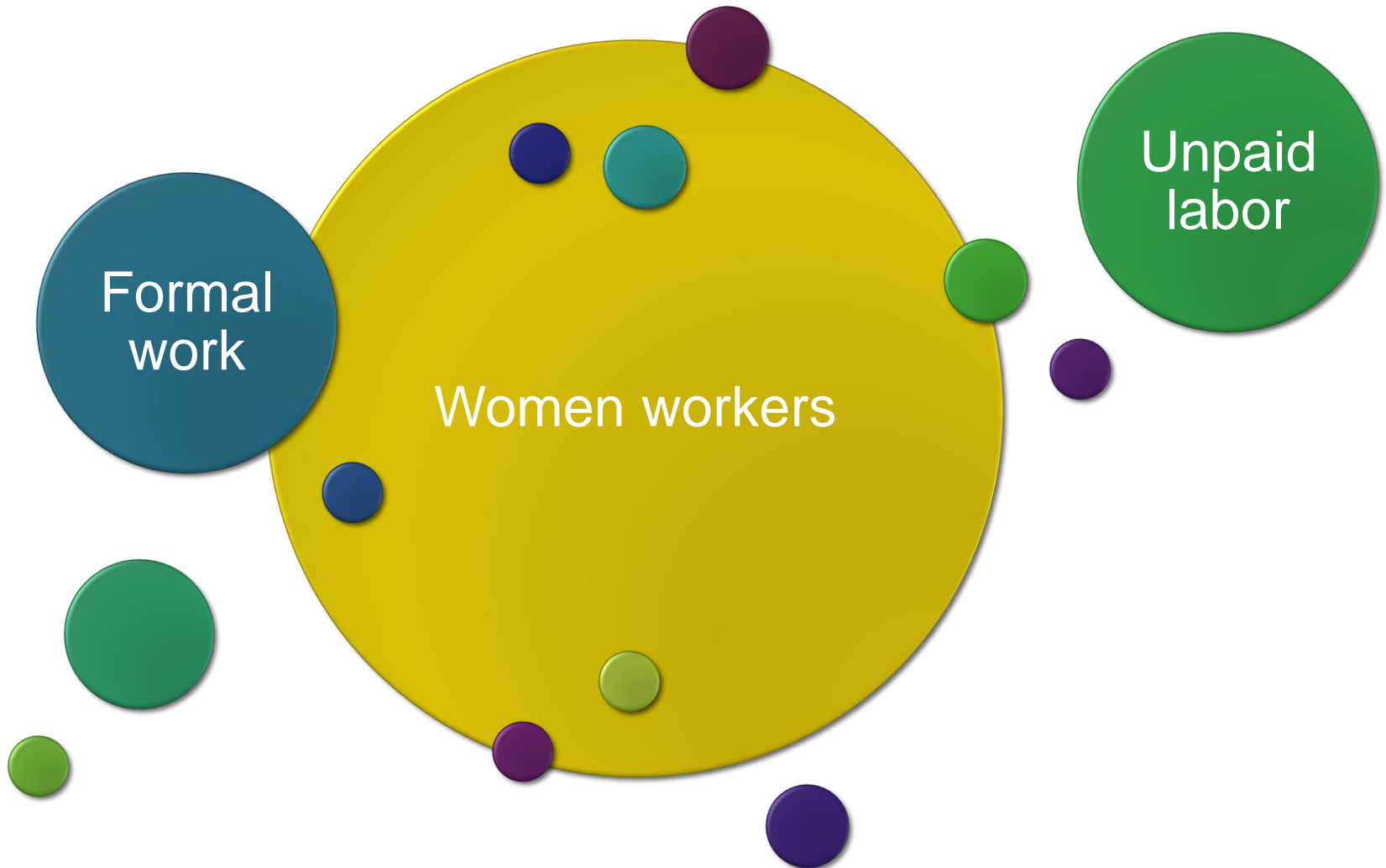
