

  - Retain current CEIP role.





# 1. POPs Workshop

- Presentations & Expert led discussion groups
- Conclusions
  1. The informal POPs expert network (led by UK) is planning a survey of national representatives
  2. Parties not compiling POPs estimates were strongly encouraged to take the first steps
  3. Luxembourg offered to start a paper listing the issues associated with historic EFs.
  4. A list of sources not currently included in the GB will be compiled (GB update in project).
  5. The emissions inventory community will endeavour to better explain the limitations of POPs estimates.
