Introduction

The secretariat and the Chairs of the Working Group on Strategies and Review and of the Working Group on Effects will inform the Steering Body about matters arising from the thirty-first session of the Executive Body, as well as relevant issues arising from the fifty-first session of the Working Group on Strategies and Review and the thirty-first session of the Working Group on Effects. The Chair of the Steering Body will present a summary of the work of the Bureau of the Steering Body between the Steering Body's thirty-sixth and thirty-seventh sessions, including cooperation with the Working Group on Effects.

Expected outcome

The Steering Body is expected to discuss and provide guidance for further work on cooperation with other bodies under the Convention and the future activities of the Bureau.

4. Update of the Guidelines for reporting of emission data under the Convention

Tentative timing: Monday, 9 September, 10.30 –11.30 a.m.

Introduction

The co-Chairs of the Task Force on Emission Inventories and Projections (TFEIP) will present a proposal for an update to the Guidelines for reporting of emission data under the Convention. The proposed updated Guidelines include changes introduced to reflect recent amendments of the Gothenburg Protocol¹, Protocol on Heavy Metals and Protocol on Persistent Organic Pollutants, as well as introduction of the new EMEP grid projection and spatial resolution.

Expected outcome

The Steering Body is expected to discuss the proposed updated Guidelines and forward the document for adoption by the Executive Body at its thirty-second session in December 2013.

5. Adjustments under the Gothenburg Protocol to emission reduction commitments or to inventories for the purposes of comparing total national emissions with them

The representatives of TFEIP will present the proposal for a template to be used by Parties when submitting a request for application of the adjustment procedure following the Executive Body Decisions 2012/, 2012/4 and 2012/12.

Expected outcome

The Steering Body is expected to consider and approve the proposed template, and the procedure on how to formally apply it.

6. Progress in activities in 2013 and future work

Tentative timing: Monday, 9 September, 12.00 - 1 p.m. 3 - 5 p.m.,

Tuesday 10 September 10 a.m. -1 p.m.

Introduction

The Steering Body is expected to consider progress in the activities of EMEP and may wish to consider aspects of future work in relation to the draft 2014-2015 workplan for the implementation of the Convention (informal document 1). Centres and Task Forces will present the highlights, main achievements and difficulties in the implementation of the 2013-2013 workplan, and their relevance in connection with the goals of the long-term strategy of the Convention (EB Decision 2010/18). Centres should also present new ideas on how reporting might change in the future.

(a) Measurements and modelling (acidification, eutrophication and photo-oxidants, heavy metals, particulate matter and persistent organic pollutants)

Introduction

The four status reports listed above that are relevant for the evaluation of the progress in work in 2013 will be available on the EMEP website (www.emep.int). Under this sub-item, representatives of the EMEP task forces and centres will report on progress on measurements and modelling activities as outlined below:

- (a) The Co-Chairs of the Task Force on Measurements and Modelling will report on progress, including the results of the fourteenth meeting of the Task Force (Zagreb, Croatia, 6-7 May 2013);
- (b) Meteorological Synthesizing Centre-West (MSC-W) will give an overview of the activities on monitoring and modelling of acidification, eutrophication and photo-oxidants, including progress made by the Chemical Coordinating Centre (CCC), the Centre for Integrated Assessment Modelling (CIAM), its own work, discussions within the Task Force on Measurements and Modelling and plans for future work until the end of 2015;
- (c) Meteorological Synthesizing Centre-East (MSC-E) will present an overview of the activities on monitoring and modelling of heavy metals, progress by CCC, its own work, discussions within the Task Force on Measurements and Modelling and plans for future work until the end of 2015;
- (d) CCC will present an overview of activities on atmospheric monitoring and modelling of particulate matter (PM), including with respect to work at MSC-W and CIAM, its own work, the results of the Task Force on Measurements and Modelling and plans for future work until the end of 2015;
- (e) MSC-E will present an overview of activities on monitoring and modelling of persistent organic pollutants, including with respect to work at CCC, its own work, the results of the Task Force on Measurements and Modelling and plans for future work until the end of 2015.

Expected outcome

The Steering Body is expected: (a) to approve the executive summaries of the 2013 status reports and to decide to present them to the Executive Body; (b) to discuss the status of implementation of the monitoring strategy; (c) to discuss progress made with respect to cooperation with national experts and provide guidance on means for its improvement; (d) to discuss progress made in modelling and monitoring activities in 2013 in all the above areas of work and to provide guidance on the further development of that work; and (e) to provide guidance on the further development of the measurement and modelling work.

(b) Integrated assessment modelling

Introduction

The Chair of the Task Force on Integrated Assessment Modelling (TFIAM) will report on progress made, including the results of the forty-second meeting held in Copenhagen, Denmark, 22-23 April 2013. CIAM will report on progress made, including the status of the Assessment Report of the Amended Gothenburg Protocol (informal document 6).

Expected outcome

The Steering Body is expected to discuss progress made and to provide further guidance on the integrated assessment modelling work.

(c) Emissions

Introduction

The Chair of the Task Force on Emission Inventories and Projections will report on progress made, including the results of the Task Force's twenty-sixth meeting and fourteenth joint meeting with the European Environment Agency's (EEA) European Environment Information and Observation Network (EIONET) (Istanbul, Turkey, 14-15 May 2013).

At this year's meeting the Task Force concentrated on the following four issues: revision of the guidelines for reporting emissions under the Convention, adjustment procedure under the Gothenburg Protocol and recent updates to EMEP/EEA Emissions Inventory Guidebook². The TFEIP meeting was held back-to-back with a technical workshop on emission projections and scenarios and strengths and weaknesses of emission inventories.

CEIP will inform the Steering Body about the status of emissions data reporting, its own work and the work of CIAM on data quality. It will report on progress in the inventory improvement programme, in particular as regards the stage 3 in-depth reviews of the emission inventories.

Expected outcome

The Steering Body is expected to discuss progress made and to provide guidance on the emissions work.

(d) Hemispheric air pollution

Introduction:

The Co-Chairs of the Task Force on Hemispheric Transport of Air Pollution will report on: the results of its recent meeting (Geneva, Switzerland, 20-22 March 2013). The TF meeting was held in conjunction with the Global Atmospheric Watch 2013 Symposium organized by World Meteorological Organization, at the same place on 18-20 March 2013.

Expected outcome

The Steering Body is expected to discuss and approve the main findings of the Task Force and to provide guidance on the hemispheric transport of air pollution work.

7. Information sharing from Parties on implementation of the EMEP Programme

Tentative timing: Tuesday, 10 September, 3-5 p.m.

Introduction

Parties' representatives are invited to prepare and present their national experiences in implementing monitoring and modelling activities under the EMEP Programme. Parties are requested to present both successes in the implementation as well as obstacles to it.

Expected outcome

The Steering Body is expected to consider the national experiences presented at the session and to recommend that similar exchanges of information are continued in the future sessions of the Steering Body.

8. Cooperation with other organizations and programmes

Tentative timing: Tuesday, 10 September, 5 - 5.30 p.m.

Introduction

The organizations and programmes represented at the session will be invited to briefly present their work and their cooperation with EMEP.

Expected outcome

The Steering Body is expected to take note of the information and to decide on further cooperation.

9. Outreach and sharing information with other regions

Introduction

The secretariat will draw attention to the decision taken at the Executive Body's twenty-fifth session, encouraging subsidiary bodies to share their experience and

information with other regions. The secretariat will inform about the current and planned outreach activities carried under the convention.

Expected outcome

Centres and subsidiary bodies are expected to draw attention to relevant current outreach activities and to suggest opportunities for developing further outreach links in the future.

It is expected that the discussion will focus on Assessment Report for the Amended Gothenburg Protocol (informal document 6.), a joint EMEP-WGE assessment report planned for completion in 2015, country reports, issues of common relevance for the review of the Convention work, issues emerged from the Salsjöbaden V workshop (Gothenburg, Sweden, 24-26 June 2013), common websites and other issues of common interest.

Expected outcome

The Steering Body is expected to consider the information presented under this agenda item and to give recommendations for joint future activities by EMEP and WGE communities.
