At its thirty-second session, held in Geneva from 9 to 11 December 2014, the Committee followed up on decision VI/2 of the Meeting of the Parties to the Convention, including actions by Ukraine to meet the recommendations relating to the Danube-Black Sea Deep Water Navigation Canal in the Ukrainian sector of the Danube Delta (EIA/IC/S/1).

You are now invited to provide specific information on the process of the preparation of the draft bilateral agreement with Ukraine on the implementation of the Convention.
