(FREE PARKING PLACES) (DISABLED PERSONS)
(NO.180) TRAFFIC ORDER 2012
Provision of Disabled Persons Parking Places**

- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Merton under the powers conferred by Sections 6 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and all other enabling powers has made the above mentioned Order. The Order was made on 29th February 2012, and shall come into force on 5th March 2012.
- The general effect of the Order will be to:-
 - designate parking places in the roads listed on the Schedule to this Notice in which vehicles authorised by the Order may be left for any period during the permitted hours without charge;
 - provide that the parking place will operate at all times unless otherwise stated;
 - specify, in respect of the parking place, that disabled persons' vehicles displaying, in the relevant position, a disabled persons badge (commonly referred to as "the Blue Badge") issued by any local authority under the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 2000 may be left therein; and
 - provide that certain vehicles may wait in the parking places in certain circumstances, e.g. to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), etc.
- A copy of the Order and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Order and a plan which indicates each length of road to which the Order relates can be inspected at Merton Link, Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden, Surrey.
- Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within six weeks from the date which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
