Dear members of the Aarhus Convention secretariat,

during the hearing on 3 July 2019, we discussed the question whether the operator of the Dukovany nuclear power plant (CEZ) needed the decisions State Officer for Nuclear Safety (SUJB) as a precondition for continued operation of the four units after 30 years or not as the Czech side claimed.

As recommended, we asked for the requests, CEZ filed with SUJB concerning Dukovany units 1-4 and promptly received them under the information request law.

There it is clear that those four permits which were requested are a precondition for continued operation after 30 years of operation of each unit as the previous license expired. Please find attached the Czech originals of the four requests as well as short translations of key text passages thereof.

The [requests](#) also mention "Limits and Conditions of a safe operation" as documents on the necessary changes for prolonged operation.

We stand ready to submit any further information or translation if needed.
