Dear Ms. MARSHALL,

Herewith the Ministry of Agriculture, Regional Development and Environment of the Republic of Moldova avails itself of this opportunity to extend its compliments to the Secretariat of the Aarhus Convention Compliance Committee.

Please be informed that the documentation related to case ACCC/C/2017/147, has been fully examined by the person responsible for the national implementation of the Aarhus Convention. The analysis included the initial address information of the communicant „Eco Tiras” to the Committee, the accompanying documents, including other information published on the website of the Compliance Committee of the Aarhus Convention.

In the context of the above, it should be noted that the communicant expresses several allegations based on its own whispering due to the less reasonable price charged by the public authority in exchange for the information held. These accusatory, with less probative aspects, need to be elucidated and clarified in order to eliminate such cases in the future.

In this sense, we have attached the Party's concerned answers to the questionnaire (5 pages), for which we reserve the right to continue to come up with new issues, for the purpose of comprehensive assessment of the situation, and amicable settlement, as is normal.
