



ANOUNCEMENT on further public consultation process regarding the draft National Integrated Energy and Climate Change Plan 2021-2030

According to EU Regulation 2018/1999 on the governance of energy union and climate action, each Member State is responsible for finalizing, until 31.12.2019, the NIPECC for the period 2021-2030, a document containing the set of policies, strategies and measures through which Member States will contribute to achieving the objectives of the Energy Union and, in particular, the climate and energy policy objectives for 2030 in the field of reducing greenhouse gas emissions, renewable energy and energy efficiency in accordance with the particularities and national priorities of each state.

Given the complexity of such a national plan, the difficulty of establishing a balanced package of policies, strategies and measures to ensure safe, sustainable, competitive and affordable energy, as well as the interest shown by stakeholders to have a longer time available for the analysis of this document, the Ministry of Energy decided to extend the public consultation process on the draft NIPECC, with a view to gathering from interested parties suggestions, suggestions and opinions, recommendations on this important document strategic.

At the same time, in order to facilitate the process of internal / external consultation of the NIPECC by the interested parties, the Ministry of Energy posts on its own website the draft NIPECC in Romanian and English, which are the versions that have been notified to the European Commission at the end of December 2018, according to the provisions of Regulation 2018/1999 on the governance of energy union and climate action.
