EIA screening



Projects listed in Annex II to the Directive are not automatically subjected to an environmental impact assessment.

Member States can decide to subject them to an assessment on a case-by-case basis or according to thresholds and/or criteria (for example size), location (sensitive ecological areas in particular) and potential impact (surface affected, duration).

The process of determining whether an assessment is required for a project listed in Annex II is called screening.

Annex II includes:

Any change or extension of projects listed in Annex I or this Annex, already authorised, executed or in the process of being executed, which may have significant adverse effects on the environment (change or extension not included in Annex I)





Concerns about environmental and health impacts

Citizens may have environmental concerns about changes or extension to existing activities/projetcs (especially project relating to energy, waste, water treatment...)

Benefit of Public consultation


help the EIA screening to properly address relevant issues, including those perceived as being important by local communities and affected groups

Help to address risk perceptions and public concerns:

The way the public – people with a generalized knowledge – perceive environment and health impact does not always align with the best estimates of the effect provided by scientific experts

The Ministry of the Environment, or the competent regional authorities, may decide to acquire and evaluate possible observations sent after the legal deadline, according to the time framework set by Legislative Decree 156/2006 as added or amended, for the implementation of preliminary and technical activities and for issuing the final proceeding.





EIA decision

"The EIA decision shall take into account the comments received considering them simultaneously, individually or in groups"



Monitoring the effectiveness



The inclusion of the views of the affected and interested public helps to ensure the decision making process is equitable and fair and leads to more informed choice and better environmental outcomes.

Public involvement in key early stage of the EIA process:

screening

determining the need for, and level, of the EIA process

take account of the information and views that may be useful for decision making

reduce conflict through the early identification of contentious issues

improve transparency and accountability of decision-making

increase public confidence in the EIA process

Monitoring the effectiveness



take account of the information and views that may be useful for decision making

gain a better understanding of the nature and significance of the likely impacts

reduce conflict through the early identification of contentious issues the early identification of affected parties and their concerns provides information that can be incorporated into the scoping stage of EIA and assists future planning for public involvement

improve transparency and accountability of decision-making the information can assist in determining if an EIA is required and at what level

projects with significant environmental impacts should not escape the EIA!
