


# **Swiss parkland until 2008**

# Swiss parks in 2016

- 1 new national park in creation
- 14 new **regional nature parks**, 1 in creation
- 1 established peri-urban park, 1 in creation



# Use Legal bases

Entry into force on 1<sup>st</sup> December 2007:

- Federal Act on the Protection of Nature and Cultural Heritage
  - Parks of national importance are areas with high natural and landscape values (Art. 23 NCHA)
- > Ordinance on Parks of National Importance

## Participatory involvement

#### 1. Regional initiative

#### 2. Park authority

- Concerned communes must be properly represented
- The participation of the local population, interested businesses and organisations must be guaranteed

#### 3. Programme agreement Global Financial Aid

Between the canton concerned and FOEN

#### 4. Charter on park management

- Drawn up and implemented by the park authority and communes, in consultation with the canton
- 5. Communal vote on the charter
- 6. Renewal of the charter after ten years



# Reasons for engaging in a participative process

## 1. Necessity for a different approach:

 Choosing a top-down approach is not very promising due to the political system in Switzerland

### 2. Enhance acceptance:

- Facilitation of the implementation process
- Avoidance of conflicts of interests

## 3. Ensure the functioning of the park

 The local communities need to profit from the park to achieve the goals of the park
