
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





- The population - 9 475 thousand people.

Negative reason




Reduced mortality and increased life expectancy


Objective 1. Protection of the rights and dignity of elderly people, social inclusion

continuing labour activity, saving labour efficiency;


anti-age discrimination in hiring, keeping, promotion and firing of employees;

development of voluntary additional pension insurance schemes




Objective 3. Lifelong learning, broadening access to education

Objective 4. Healthy and safe life of elderly people, active ageing


promoting health-saving lifestyles at all stages of life

development of home-based forms of social services and services at day care centres


development of technologies to care for elderly people with dementia

involvement of non-governmental organizations in the provision of social services





Objective 6. Adapting infrastructure and age-friendly living environment
