- Binding agreements need clear information
- Importance of networks in developing indicators
- Selection of appropriate data sources
- Importance of guidance to users

- Integration of economic/social/environmental aspects
- Competitive vs. Multifunctional agriculture and AEIs
- Distinguish "standards" and "indicators"
- Appropriate geographic resolution
- Optimal number of indicators
- Papers make extensive use of existing data
