Prime Minister Sanna Marin's Government:

- Carbon neutral Finland by 2035 & carbon negative soon after that
→ accelerate emissions reductions & strengthen carbon sinks
- Govt committed to reform EU & national climate policies to do our part towards ~ 1.5°C objective
- Transform EU policies so that EU is carbon neutral before 2050 → 2030 target ↑ to at least -55 %
- Continue Nordic cooperation towards carbon neutrality & strengthen leadership in international climate policy

Carbon neutral Finland by 2035




- Achievable target
